COSTELLO: I GOT THAT ABBOTT, MY WHOLE FAMILY WAS HIGH CLASS
ACTORS...MY AUNT MINNIE WAS A FAN DANCER!

(FAST) HELLO, YES THIS IS BUD ABBOTT. O.K. I'LL TELL ABBOTT: COSTELLO

SOUND: RECEIVER UP

WHAT WAS THAT? COSTELLO:

THAT WAS UNIVERSAL STUDIOS . . . THEY SAID THEY ARE SORRY BUT ABBOTT: THEY WON'T BE ABLE TO COMPLETE OUR LATEST PICTURE "THE NAUGHTIE NINETIES" UNTIL THEY ARE ABLE TO SECURE A DRAMATIC ACTRESS TO PLAY THE FINAL SCENE. FIELDS: WELCOME TO THE SCHOOL OF SPANISH ACTING GENTLEMEN...I AM SEENIOR MELLONHEAD!

COSTELLO: SEENYOUR MELLONHEAD? I'VE SEEN-YOUR-MELLONHEAD AROUND
HERE FOR TEN WEEKS!..AND IT'S STARTIN' TO GET RIPE!

ABBOTT: COSTELLO, I'M SURPRISED AT YOU! SENIOR MELLONHEAD IS A GREAT ARTIST!

COSTELLO: THEN WHY DON'T HE PAINT SOME HAIR ON HIS DOME?...HIS

SCALP RUNS ALL THE WAY DOWN TO HIS HEELS!

FIELDS: YOUNG MAN, BEFORE I MARRIED MY WIFE, I HAD HAIR AS BLACK
AS THE ACE OF SPADES!

COSTELLO: IT LOOKS LIKE YOUR WIFE TRUMPED YOUR ACE:....MELLONHEAD
WAS YOUR WHOLE FAMILY BALD?

FIELDS: NOT EXACTLY. OF COURSE FOR MANY YEARS MY MOTHER DID HAVE
A RAT IN HER HAIR.

COSTELLO: MELLONHEAD, THAT'S NO WAY TO TALK ABOUT YOUR FATHER:

ABBOTT: COSTELLO BE QUIET, SENIOR MELLONHEAD COSTELLO WANTS TO PLAY THE PART OF A PRETTY SPANISH GIRL...CAN YOU COACH HIM??

FIELDS: CAN I COACH HIM? I LOOK WITH PRIDE ON MY SPANISH ANCESTRY.

IN MY VEINS FLOWS THE BLOOD OF CORTEZ, THE BLOOD OF DE

SOTO, THE BLOOD OF BALBOA AND THE BLOOD OF PONCE DE LEON!

COSTELLO: MELLONHEAD, DOES THE BLOOD BANK KNOW ABOUT YOU?

FIELDS: CAN I COACH HIM?...GENTLEMEN I AM A GREAT AUTHORITY

ABBOTT: TALK SENSE COSTELLO...LET'S GET ON WITH THE LESSONS!

FIELDS: VERY WELL, WE'LL SAY THAT YOU ARE LOVELY SPANISH

SENIORETA YOU MEET A GAY CABALLERO AT YOUR FIESTA, WHEN

HE SEES YOU, HE PLAYFULLY CLICKS HIS CASTINETTES AND BANGS

HIS MORACCAS TOGETHER!

COSTELLO: HE DOES?

FIELDS: YES. AND DO YOU KNOW WHAT YOU DO?
