RADIO DRAMA: 1932 - 1959

n American dynasty, One Man's Family, written by Carlton E. Morse, became the most addictive show of its time. For 27 years, listeners were introduced to an all new phenomenon: the soap opera. Here was a program that provided a slice of life with a feeling of reality

that no other radio show could duplicate. Henry "Father" Barbour (played for its entire run by J. Anthony Smythe), a retired stockbroker, and Fanny "Mother" Martin Barbour (played for 23 years by Minetta Ellen, then by Mary Adams) raised a family of five children: Paul, Hazel, twins Claudia and Clifford, and the youngest son, Jack. Father became known as the overbearing but lovable head of the family. Mother was the peacemaker trying to undo some of Henry's well-meaning blunders. Through it all, fans came to know the lives of these people. They saw them

RADIO COMEDY: 1935 - 1959

he #1 rated show of 1941 (topping even Jack Benny and Bob Hope), "Fibber McGee" (Jim Jordan) and his faithful, long-suffering wife "Molly" (Marian Jordan) spent 24 years bringing their comedic blunders to audiences across the country. Childhood sweethearts from Peoria, actors Jim and Marian Jordan had performed together in vaudeville and on radio, but it was the "McGee's" who made them stars. Sponsored by

Johnson Wax, the show unconventionally and often hysterically incorporated the Johnson Wax salesman into the action of the program (rather than stop for a commercial break). Each year brought a humorous host of supporting characters that included Teeny, Abigail Uppington, Myrt, Alice, Dr. Gamble, and Throckmorton P. Gildersleeve, who later left to star in his own successful show. (See below).

The Great Gildersleeve

RADIO COMEDY: 1941 - 1957



ormer neighbor and rival of Fibber McGee, Throckmorton P. Gildersleeve arrived in Summerfield in 1941 to begin his curiously crazy reign as the town's Water Commissioner and most eligible bachelor. "Gildy" also took on the formidable task of raising his nephew and niece, Leroy and Marjorie. Gildersleeve was

played by Harold Peary for almost 10 years, after which Willard Waterman took over. During its successful run, mem-

orable characters such as Judge Horace Hooker (with whom Gildy had a long-running feud), Peavey, the hen-pecked druggist and Birdie, the Gildersleeve cook brought laughter and pleasure to millions of Americans.

rom the hills of Arkansas, Lum Edwards (Chester Lauck) and Abner Peabody (Norris Goff) brought a mixture of down-home hillbilly comedy and silly soap opera antics to radio. For 23 years people tuned in to their continuing adventures in Pine Ridge. Lauck and Goff's "Jot 'Em Down Store" was inspired by friend Dick Huddleston's store in Waters, Arkansas. As Lum & Abner grew in popularity, Dick lead the drive to change the town's name to Pine Ridge--which it did! For 10 years, Lauck and Goff wrote, handled sound effects and played all the characters including Cedric Weehunt, Grandpappy Spears, Snake Hogan (all played by Lauck) and Squire Skimp and Mousy Gray (played by Goff). The show grew, but the simple flavor continued with the squeak of the store's screen door and Abner's catch phrase, "I doggies, Lum..."
