Capt. Rick's collection of radio shows on tape

MATAWAN - Remember how you could hardly wait for Sunday so you could tune in "The Shadow" on radio and find out what new evil was lurking in the hearts of men? Remember the Lone Ranger and Tonto and all those thrilling days of vestervear? How about "Lux Radio Theater" and all the other great old radio shows you loved so much Do you wish you could hear some of them again? Do you wish, even more,that your children could have the opportunity of experiencing the kind of entertainment you had as a youngster? If so, visit the Matawan library on Oct. 28 at 1:30 p.m. and these wishes will come true. Matawan's Richard B. Wolfe (alias Capt. Rick) will be on hand with two tapes of original radio broadcasts from his extensive collection. The special Hallowe'en children's presentation will feature "The Ghost Who Didn't Know How to Laugh" from the House of Mystery series, and a Lone Ranger program.

What prompts a man to amass a tape collection of some 15,000 hours of radio programs over a 20 year period? "First of all, I'm a collector. I collect anything and-everything. But I also have a sense of timing. I have been taping since the early 50's because I anticipated that TV would almost eradicate radio and I wanted to save what I liked. Now I feel that I would like to share these moments from my childhood and radio with other people, especially children." And so Capt. Rick was born. The Captain, complete with yachting cap,

blazer, and white bucks, is the character Wolfe becomes when he produces and narrates his radio shows for a primarily juvenile audience.

Mr. Wolfe's tape collection includes 24 or 25 "Let's Pretend" programs which were originated and scripted by Nyla Mack, plus at least the first and last broadcasts of as many shows as he could get. Some of his tapes were obtained by swapping with other people around the country who have the same hobby. His interest and research on the subject of radio led him to form his own Old-Tyme Radio Co. in Healet through which other radio buffs may obtain cassette tapes for their own collections. Mr. Wolfe finds that tapes are good gifts and a fine way to keep children entertained on long trips.

When Uncle Rick puts away his yachting cap and biazer, he is known as Richard B. Wolfe, an attorney specializing in medical trail work, who lives in Strathmore with is wife and "great booster". Lillian: two children Brian, 7, and Stacey, 4, and a Boston buil terrier named Bubbles who sleeps with her eyes open and snores. He is a former president of the Democratic Club in Matawan Township; the co-editor, cartoonist, and photographer for the Democrat's county newspaper. He ran for public office two years ago and was the only candidate who fought for teen centers. He is now seeing one of his dreams come true with the newly planned teen center in the township. He would like to work with Matawan teens in

setting up the center and then lecture and contribute tapes and films for the center's own use. Mr. Wolfe would use his experience with the Trinity Church teen center in New York City as a basis for a recreation program in Matawan.

Mr. Wolfe's collecting extends to old 8 mm films, model airplanes, war relics, "about 40 years worth" of campaign buttons and posters. He enjoys photography, writing for the newspapers, riding a bike and traveling. He "loves drama" and his tapes and films which are "meticulously cataloged" include many classic dramatic presentations.

The library hopes to have a series of children's programs by Dick Wolfe in future, with a possibility of an adult evening presentation. Along with his tapes and narrations, Mr. Wolfe car, provide all sorts of fascinating information such as the fact that Danny Thomas used to play a character called Thunder Martin on the Lone Ranger series. Richard Wolfe loves to talk about and answer questions concerning radio and collecting and his hobbies. But don't ask hin: about old beer cans. He doesn't collect those.

How To Order:

Always look for either a number or letter. after the program you wish to order and include that designation with the order.

It is suggested that no programs be ordered without enclosing an additional 25¢ for insurance. Our company will not replace recordings otherwise if lost in the mail. If insured, the replacement will be made after verification of the loss.

As regards the fidelity of the recordings ... every recording is spot checked on two machines, a Norelco and a Bell and Howell cassette recorder. With the exception possibly of some very cheap machines, the tapes should play comfortably well. The tape used in most instances is TDK tape under the Singer Manufacturing label.

Wherever possible I have specified in this catalog those tapes I know to be less than adequate in listening. Fair means there are noticable defects but it is listenable. Good means the volume may fluctuate or their may be some background noise or slight muffling, but the tape is easily listenable.

Most of the recordings have stood well the test of time and with few exceptions approximate high fidelity quality.
