

Dear Radiofolk:

A warm welcome to all our new friends and customers who are seeing our Radiola and Sandy Hook catalogue for the first time, and a "hello again" to all the old-timers, some of you still with us after 24 years! I'm introducing a new format for our Radiola and Sandy Hook products, one that not only follows the new postal regulations (in size and shape), but one that should make it easier to find those recordings you're looking for.

For the newcomers: RADIOLA products ate taken mostly from radio programs of the past, SANDY HOOK records, cassettes and compact discs are mostly musical, taken from radio, film sound tracks, and 78 rpm records.

I've got some new releases for radio geezers and Sandy Hook beginners alike, in addition to a complete list of all the Radiola and Sandy Hooks available. Radiola #1170 "Themes Like Old Times" is actually our "Sampler," and contains the program openings of 90 of the most popular shows of all time. Available on and off since 1968, "Themes" actually rose to #23 on the charts! "One Night Stand with Harry James and His Orchestra" is actually a two hour "crate" of four complete band remotes. "One Night Stand with Benny Goodman and His Orchestra" is also a two hour "crate" of cassettes with four complete band remotes dating back to 1937. The sound is good too! Our last new "crate" has four hours of laughs with Amos 'N' Andy, 8 complete broadcasts at The Mystic Knights of the Sea!

The new Sandy Hooks are just as exciting. A "crate" of Sherlock Holmes (with Basil Rathbone and Nigel Bruce of course) with four solid hours of deduction. There's lots of music - a single cassette from Tommy Dorsey and His Orchestra and Harry James and His Orchestra, both of which feature vocals by the young, skinny and talented Frank Sinatra. Two more single cassettes feature Nat King Cole (piano solos as well as The King Cole Trio) and the one and only "Rosie the Riveter." Actually, she doesn't say a word, Rosie was just a symbol of the era (like Kilroy!) and these zany novelty tunes will help you remember Pearl Harbor (no fair listening on a Sony or driving in a Datsun while this tape is playing!).

These darn small pages don't allow me more space unless we shrink the type beyond the ability of my specs to focus. So, so long until our next supplement! Thanks for listening...until next time.
