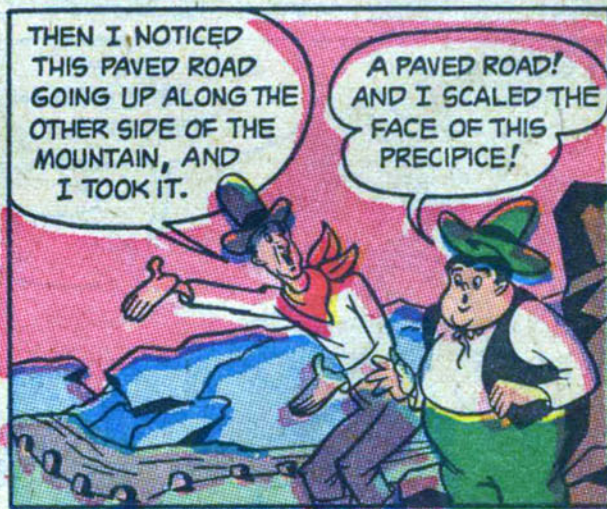
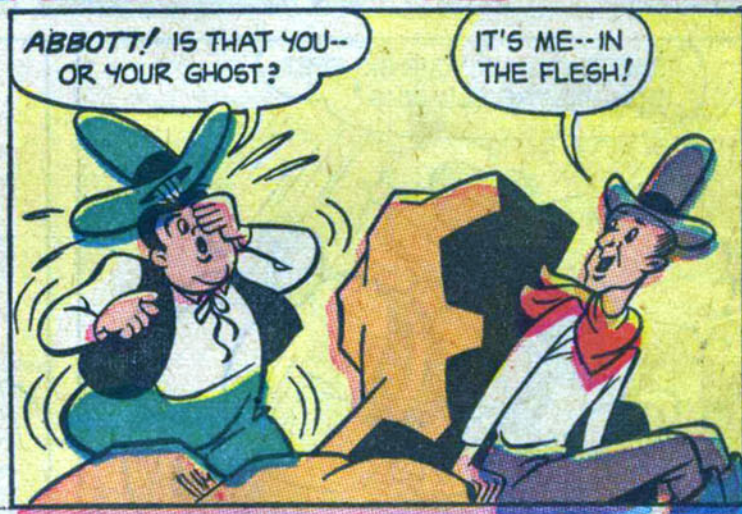
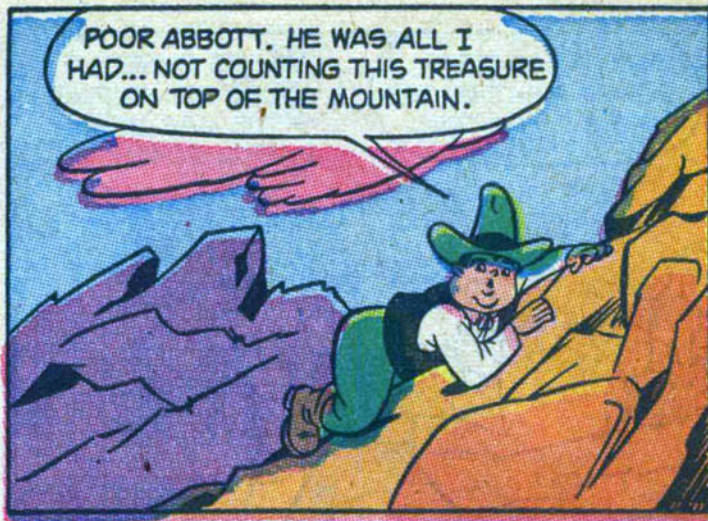




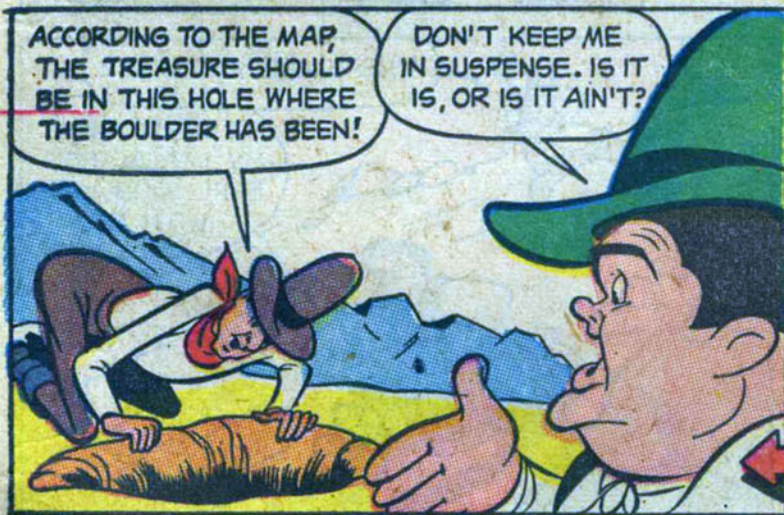




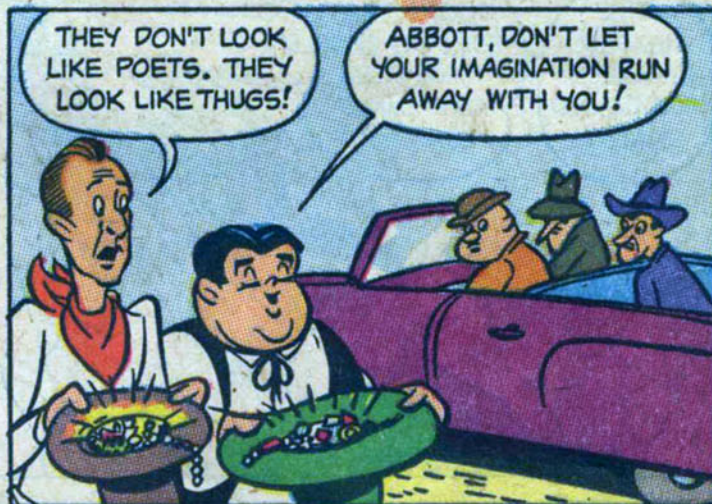




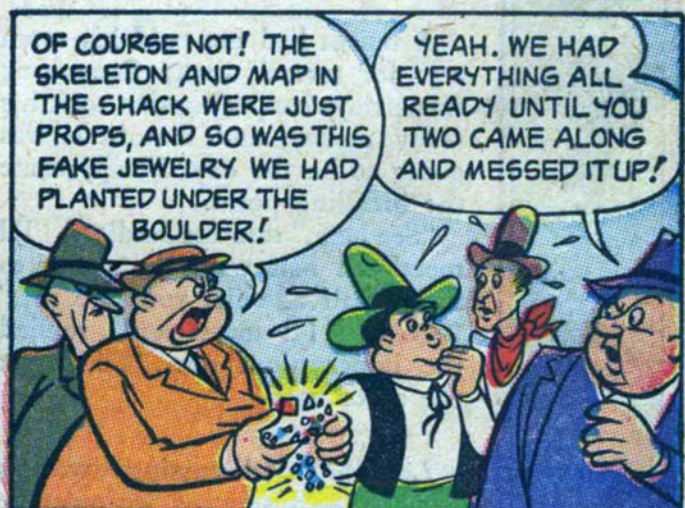
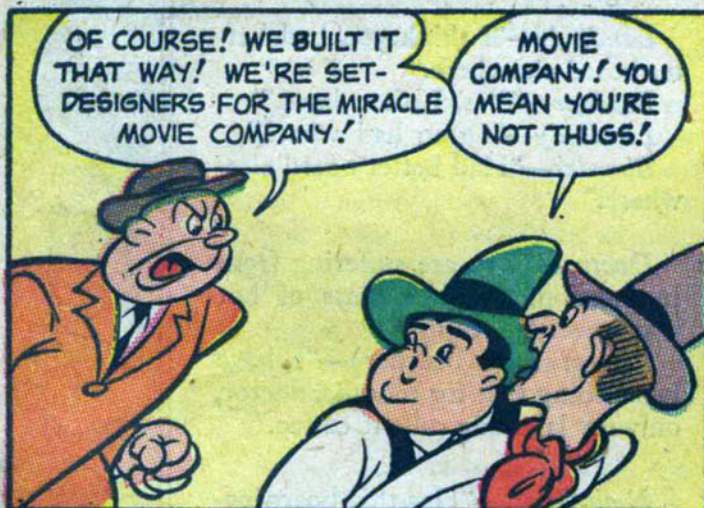
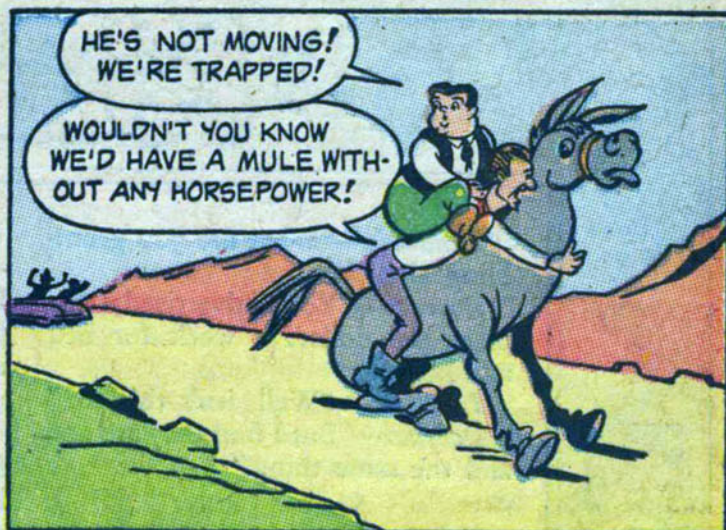














# COMEDY COLUMN

"Some people would kick anywhere but in a football game," snorted the restaurant proprietor. "I can't see what them epicures has got to complain about with this soup."

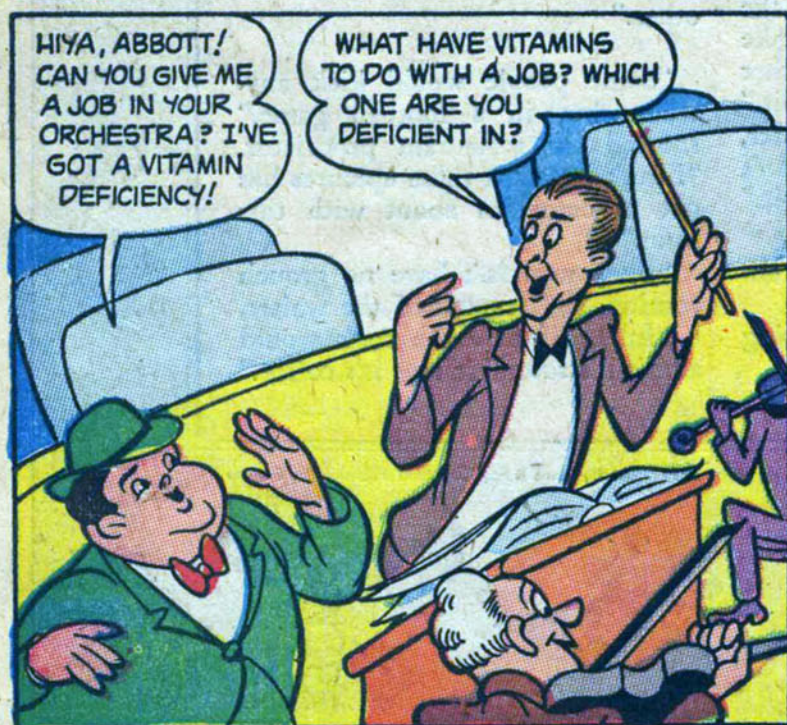
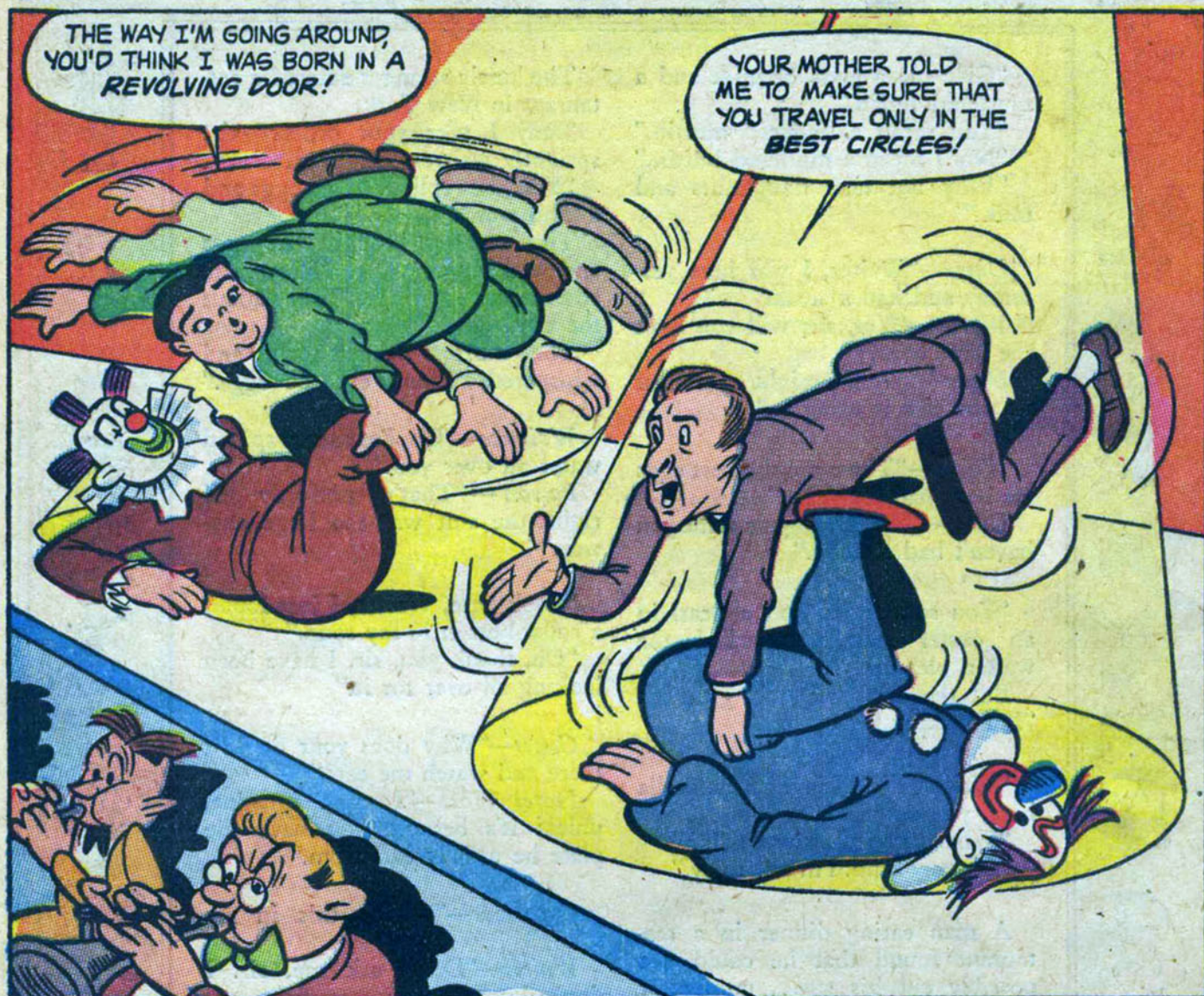
