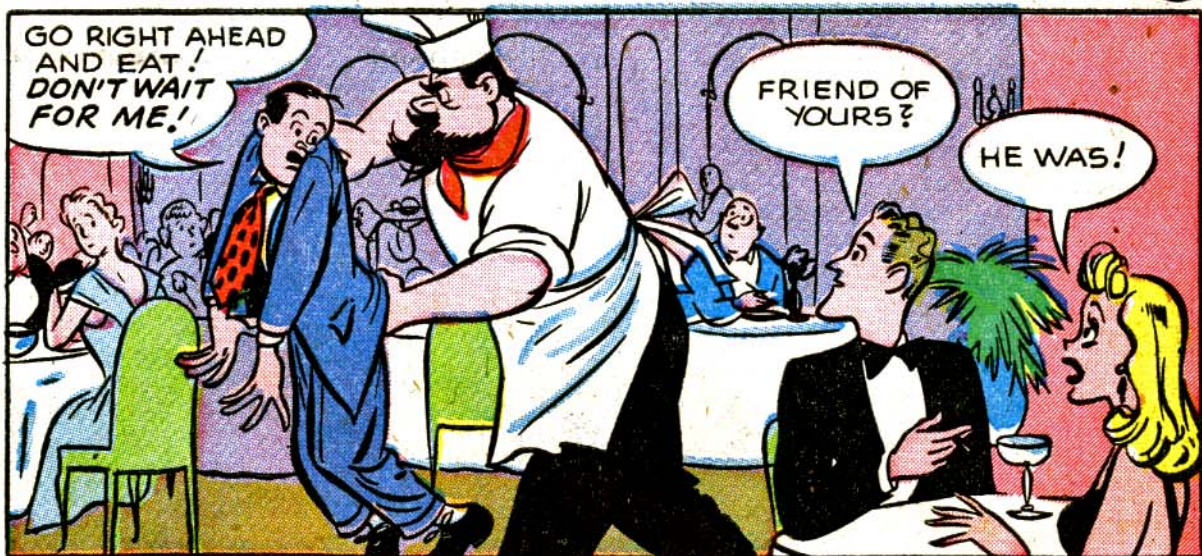












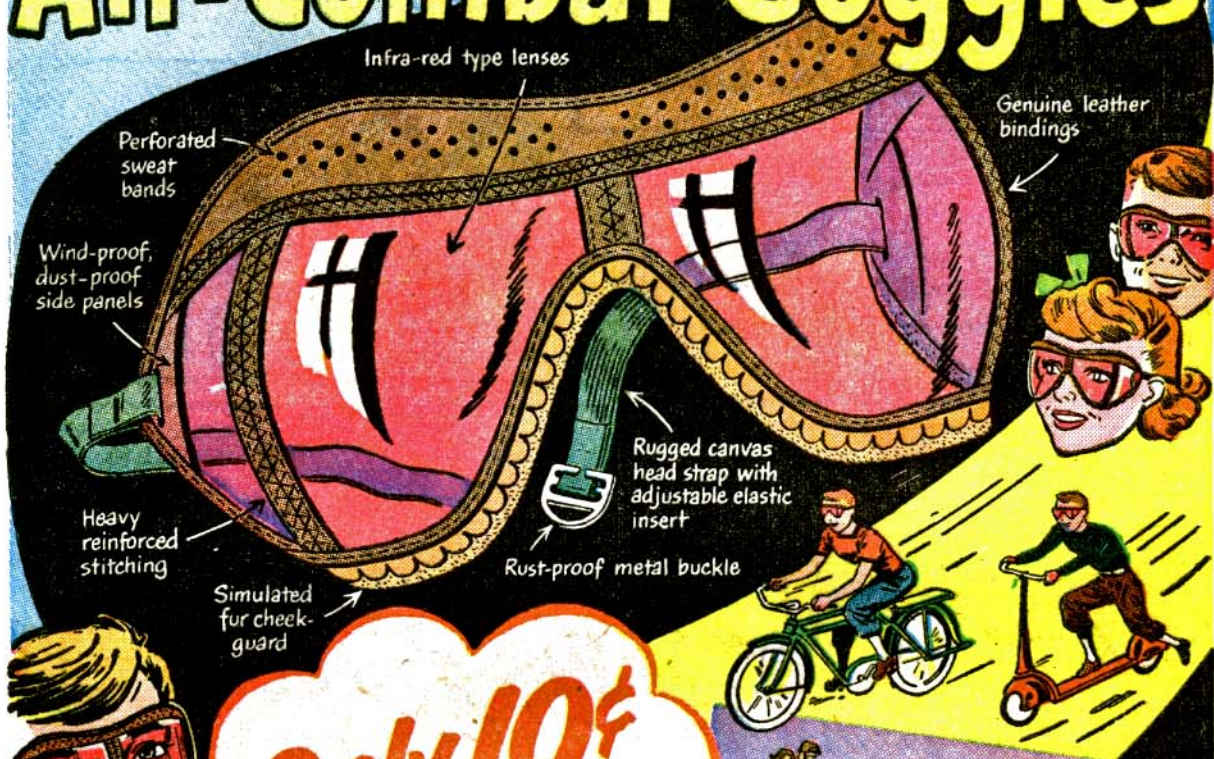
Meet...

Mrs. Howard loaned the material to Warner Brothers for research purposes on "The Story of Seabiscuit."

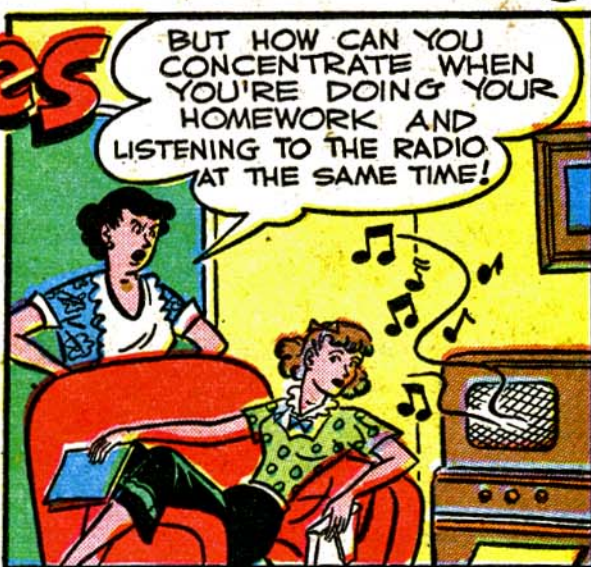
