Hi there, record fans! One of the most enjoyable evenings to be had in New York is seeing the hit musical comedy, "Guys & Dolls." DECCA RECORDS has the entire original cast, Vivian Blaine, Sam Levene, Robert Alda, Isabel Bigley, Johnny Silver and Stubby Kaye, singing Frank Loesser's hit tunes. "If I Were a Bell", "A Bushel and a Peck", "I'll Know", and "I've Never Been in Love Before" are just a few of the many wonderful songs that you'll be singing and humming after listening to the album. DECCA offers the album in three speeds.

M-G-M has some fine new albums for you record fans. The virile baritone of Gordon MacRae, one of America's favorite singers and movie stars, is heard in an album entitled, "Prisoner of Love" (from the old Russ Columbo number of that name). That famous song shares the spotlight with seven other top favorites—numbers like "You Go to My Head", "I Have But One Heart", "They Say It's Wonderful", and "Full Moon and Empty Arms". Romantic fare, you'll agree—and you'll also agree Gordon MacRae does an excellent job on this M-G-M waxing.

Good news for Kathryn Grayson fans! M-G-M has gathered eight wonderful songs by the lovely M-G-M Pictures and Records

star into a new album entitled, "Kathryn Grayson Sings". Kathryn leads off with her exciting version of "Jalousie", followed by "Lover Come Back to Me", "Will You Remember", "You Are Love", "Yesterdays", "Always", "Love Is Where You Find It", and "All of a Sudden My Heart Sings". Great material in great performances!

COLUMBIA RECORDS waxed the original cast of "Pal Joey", the musical comedy revival currently on Broadway. Probably you remember the number one tune on the hit parade last year, "Bewitched", and an equally popular song, "I Could Write a Book". These and many other fine Lorenz Hart and Richard Rodgers songs will leave no doubt in your mind as to why the musical was revived. It's one of the very best recordings of any show to come along.

Yma Sumac has recorded her second album for CAPITOL. Ever since she waxed "Voice of the Xtabay", her fans have been wanting to hear more and more of Miss Sumac. Now, with her new "Legend of the Sun Virgin", she rises to greater heights—if that's possible. The story concerns the worship of the Sun God by the ancient Incas, of whom Miss Sumac is a descendant. If you haven't yet heard Yma Sumac, you are missing a real treat.

Classical Corner

When Tchaikovsky composed **THE SWAN LAKE**, he presented ballet dancers with a magical score by which they could pirouette to stardom. Roger Desormiere conducts the French National Symphony Orchestra in this *Capitol* LP, with a delicate touch, which makes this beautiful dance legend as enchanting today as it was in 1877.

Ferde Grofe conducts his famous **GRAND CANYON SUITE** with the Capitol Symphony Orchestra in a new *Capitol* Classics LP. Nowhere in music is there a more vivid picture of an American wonder which is surely the ninth wonder of the world. The majestic setting of the Grand Canyon in all its spectacular beauty is dynamically depicted in the sections: Sunrise, The Painted Desert, On The Trail, Sunset, and Cloudburst.

Ten years after his death, in 1839, Franz Schubert's **SYMPHONY NO. 7 IN C MAJOR** (The Great) was introduced to the musical world. Unheard by its composer, this symphonic song is a lasting memorial to his genius. The new world of soaring moods it contains is eloquently spread before us by the Concertgebouw Orchestra of Amsterdam, conducted with rare insight by Willem Mengelberg, on a *Capitol* LP.

The history of the past two centuries comes to life through the voices of the personalities who made history in **HARK! THE YEARS!** In this priceless scrapbook in sound on a *Capitol* LP are: Florence Nightingale, Thomas Edison, William Jennings Bryan, Lillian Russel, Enrico Caruso, John Barrymore, Robert E. Peary, Theodore Roosevelt, Will Rogers, Douglas Fairbanks, Sr., Jack Dempsey, Knute Rockne, Babe Ruth, George Bernard Shaw, Dr. Albert Einstein, FDR, and many others.

Clairvoyant as a medium was Mozart in his **CONCERTO NO. 22 in E FLAT MAJOR** for PIANO & ORCHESTRA, anticipating the style of Beethoven, waiting to take his place on the stage of musical history. This LP "first" was recorded by *OCEANIC*, and presents Mozart's **CONCERTO NO. 14 in E FLAT MAJOR** on the reverse side of the disc.

A well-known institution to American summertime visitors and servicemen stationed in England during the second World War was the London Promenade Concert. First in a projected series, titled **LONDON PROMENADE CONCERT**, this *MGM* LP presents some of the highlights of a typical evening at the "Proms". Included in this group of light listening pleasure, conducted by George Weldon with the London Symphony Orchestra, are such colorful favorites as: the **BACH-CHANALE** from the opera "Samson & Delilah" and the **DANSE MACABRE**, both by Saint-Saens; Balakirev's **ISLAMEY**, an Oriental Fantasy; and the **CORTEGE DES NOBLES** from the opera "Mlada" by Rimsky-Korsakov.

A musical art gallery of brilliant paintings is Mercury Classics LP release of Moussorgsky's **PICTURES AT AN EXHIBITION**, in the Ravel orchestration. This Olympian Series disc of the popular classic has Rafael Kubelik conducting the Chicago Symphony Orchestra in a dazzling performance of Moussorgsky's unique tribute to his artist-friend Victor Hartmann, whose actual paintings were musically depicted by the composer.

Probing as a searchlight in the night skies is Haydn's **SYMPHONY NO. 103 in E-FLAT ("DRUM ROLL")**. The Bamberg Symphony Orchestra under Robert Heger plays this Mercury LP with the drama inherent in its very first notes. In lyrical contrast on the other side of this record is Haydn's **SYMPHONY NO. 102 in B-FLAT**, with the Munich Philharmonic Orchestras.

Shakespeare's plays have inspired many composers with a vast field for musical interpretation. Mercury Classics offers a new LP containing two Shakespearean Fantasias: **THE TEMPEST** and **HAMLET**. Tchaikovsky's powerful scores are dramatically played by the Stockholm Radio Symphony Orchestra under Jacques Rachmilovich in a notable contribution to musical literature for the immortal bard.


