MGM Pictures' dazzling new musical "Kiss Me Kate" will soon be coming your way! Meanwhile, here's a refreshing preview of the songs and performances you'll be hearing and seeing offered in recordings directly from the sound-track of the movie. Featured in the cast and on records are Kathryn Grayson, Howard Keel, Ann Miller, Keenan Wynn, Bobby Van, James Whitmore, Tommy Rall, and Bob Fosse—a youthful, vitally talented line-up. you'll agree.

And the Cole Porter songs they sing—well, just run your eye over the listing of 14 numbers which appear above and you'll see just what an entertaining listening session is in store for you. It's one of the finest sound-track collections offered by MGM Records to date—you'll mark it a "must" for your record shelf. The long-play version is on a twelve-inch platter, the Extended Play 45 r.p.m. version is housed in a three-pocket album set, and the 78 r.p.m. version

is in a four-pocket album which represents an unabbreviated version of the score.

Personal philosophies of thoughtful men and women, subjects of the most widely-listened-to radio program in the world, a best-selling book and a nationwide weekly newspaper feature, are now heard on records with Columbia's release of "This I Believe." The album is an outgrowth of the radio program of the same name, inaugurated by news analyst Edward R. Murrow to acquaint Americans with the beliefs of their fellow citizens.

"This I Believe" on records includes not only a group of ten commentaries previously heard on the famous radio program but a completely new second volume, presenting

the personal philosophies of ten immortals spanning the centuries from Socrates to Ghandi, written in each case by the world authority on the subject and spoken by the best portrayals. Introductory commentary in both volumes is spoken by Mr. Murrow.

Among the ten living Americans heard in "This I Believe" are Bernard Baruch, Helen Hayes, Ralph Bunche, Charles H. Percy, Mrs. Marty Mann, Eleanor Roosevelt, LoLuis B. Seltzer, Helen Keller, Will Durant and Carl Sandburg.

Contributing to the second volume of "This I Believe" are such distinguished writers and historians as Gilbert Murray, Paul M. Angles, Will Durant, Robert Sherwood, Mrs. C. Woodham-Smith, Hector Bolitho, Henry Butler Allen, Donald Day, Eve Curie and Louis Fischer. Reading their statements are Barry Jones, Raymond Massey, Katharine Cornell, Dr. Hu Shih, Helen Hayes, Jose Ferrer, and S. Radhakrishnan. Eve Curie, Franklin D. Roosevelt Jr. and Will Rogers Jr. are heard in readings of their celebrated parents' philosophies.

The idea for "This I Believe" was developed in 1949 when four businessmen sat around a luncheon table. Edward R. Murrow, news analyst, William S. Paley, Chairman of the Board of CBS, Donald W. Thornburgh, President of WCAU in Philadelphia and Ward Wheelock, a Philadelphia advertising man, sat over their coffee cups talking about the growing decline of spiritual values in a world marked by material progress. "What can be done about it?" said one. And thereupon the idea of "This I Believe" began to take shape.

It was decided to invite a chosen number of men and women—people known and unknown, of every faith and origin, representing nearly every walk of life—to tell in 600 words what they deem important in life, and to give the rules by which they run their lives. These would be spoken by the writers themselves in 5-minute radio talks, each to be introduced by Edward R. Murrow.

Today "This I Believe" is broadcast 2400 times a week in this country alone and is heard by 39 million people an average of

twice a week. "This I Believe" is heard abroad through the Voice of America, and is broadcast regularly to our armed forces. Offered by the State Department in translation to newspapers in some 97 countries, it is also a syndicated feature appearing weekly in important American newspapers with a circulation of nine and a half million a week.

Published in book form in 1952 by Simon and Schuster, "This I Believe" consisted of 100 selected scripts with foreword by Mr. Murrow. It immediately became a national best-seller—300,000 copies—outselling every other non-fiction book in America except the Bible.



Increased popular interest in high-fidelity sound has prompted Capitol Records to issue an unusual new album of "Full Dimensional Sound—a Study in High Fidelity." This record—the first of its kind—is intended to serve the dual purpose of demonstrating high-fidelity equipment and of providing listeners with fine music recorded under ideal conditions.

Musical selections, picked with this twofold aim in mind, include both popular and classical compositions, in the belief that listeners interested in fine quality sound have not limited their taste to any particular type of music.

In addition, the album includes two "Studies In Percussion," performed by Hal Rees, chief percussionist for 20th Century-Fox studios. These feature Mr. Reese on 23 different instruments, covering a broad range of the sound spectrum.

For both the experienced high-fidelity enthusiast and the beginning fan, there is included in the album a 12-page booklet. Part of the booklet is a discussion of the most significant aspects of fine music reproduction, written by Charles Fowler, editor of High Fidelity Magazine.

The booklet also explains such terms as frequency range, the recording curve, the playback curve, and advises the listener on how he may obtain best performance from the record and his equipment.

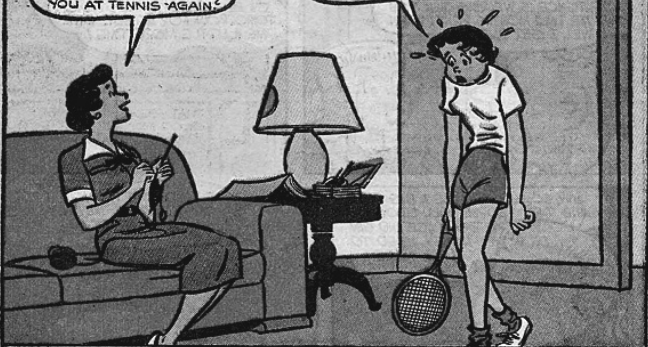

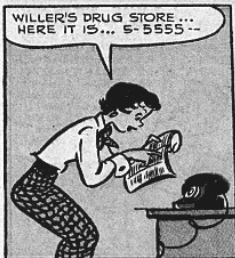

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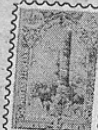
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
