Arthur Smith "the Guitar Boogie" man and his popular music group—The Crackerjacks—are in delightful form in this grouping of hillbilly and folk selections. Arthur's versatility is well displayed in this hit-slanted album. There is a wonderful folksy quality in this new album and it is sure to get plenty of attention. This is another fine M-G-M release.

Here's an M-G-M recorded salute to the "big name" dance bands of the great era of Swing that stretched across a near-two-decades in the 'Thirties and 'Forties! "THE GREAT ONES" is a title with a double appropriateness—it points to eight of the top dance band instrumentals of the past and also covers the bands that were involved. Arranger-conductor LeRoy Holmes has done an exciting job in this new album. It has dual sales appeal of the "old" favorites with added spice of modern techniques.

### "Tawny" Emerges as Next Gleason Click

Jackie Gleason's new album, "Tawny," is rapidly following the successful pattern set by previous Gleason Capitol recordings. Out only a few weeks, "Tawny" has already climbed to the lists of best-selling albums. "Tawny" is the name of a ballet suite which Gleason originally composed for his TV program. The reaction to the composition was so spontaneous that it was decided an album of the music should be recorded.

The rich string section which has been a hallmark of previous Gleason albums is again very much in evidence and Bobby Hackett's distinctive trumpet work is up to its usual high standard.

### The Clooney Touch

Rosemary demonstrates the magic Clooney touch on two widely varied ballads in her newest *Columbia* waxing.

"Tomorrow I'll Dream And Remember" is a haunting import from Sweden. A dreamy background supplied by the Percy Faith Orchestra adds to the musical spell that Rosemary casts.

The dramatic coupling is "Brave Man," written by Academy Award-winning songwriters Livingston and Evans for La Clooney's current starring film "Red Garters." Powerful as the great screen song hit "High Noon," "Brave Man" opens with an eerie drum roll, unfolds into a gripping tale of two men battling for their honor. Percy Faith again accompanies.

### "How Were They To Know It Was The Kid's Last Fight" ???

Frankie Laine has a new candidate for the best-seller mark that may well add a sixth gold platter to his collection of million-sales hits.

This one is "THE KID'S LAST FIGHT," written by versatile Bob Merrill. Accompanied by sidekick Carl Fischer at the up-right piano and the Norman Luboff choir, Frankie renders this bar-room type ballad in dramatic fashion. It's the poignant saga of a courageous pugilist's final bout.

"Long Distance Love" is the coupling.

with "Mr. Rhythm" singing solo as well as four-part harmony. Frankie wonders what has become of the queen bee in his honeycomb; he's tried a river of ink and a mountain of paper, even asked a friend to help. But now this so-called friend is "a short distance from my long distance love" and Frankie has lost the gal. Paul Weston and his Orchestra supply the lively backgrounds for this *Columbia* record.

### Bringing Out Bands

Ever since *Columbia's* release of the Benny Goodman Carnegie Hall Jazz Concert and his 1937-38 radio broadcasts, band recordings have enjoyed a renaissance in popularity. Now, after helping to bring back the classic bands of the past, *Columbia* is proceeding to showcase new ensembles on records. A new trio of bands joins the well-known ensembles of Harry James and Sammy Kaye in an expansion of *Columbia's* band repertoire.

First to be signed was the Lee Elgart band, making its debut with a highly successful album, "Sophisticated Swing." The Elgart group specializes in a crisp, clean, danceable tempo and ear-arresting sounds.

Another newcomer to the *Columbia* roster is an imaginative outfit under the baton of Pete Rugolo, famed for his compositions and arrangements for the Stan Kenton band. Rugolo's first *Columbia* singles, notable for an advanced musical style, were released in March.

Third of the new ensembles is a 19-piece aggregation sparked by the trumpet of leader Dan Terry. The West Coast bandmen, soon to embark on an extensive tour, produce hard-driving tempos and a blazing sound.

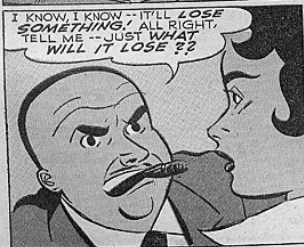

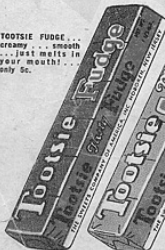
