

Two Volume "TRIBUTE TO DORSEY" Released by RCA Victor

As a memorial to the famous trombonist-bandleader Tommy Dorsey, RCA Victor this month is releasing a special two volume "Tribute to Dorsey." Both albums contain Dorsey classics which previously had not been released on long play records. The 32 numbers chosen span the recording history of Tommy Dorsey on RCA Victor records from 1936 to 1946. This tribute is being released in two separate single-record volumes rather than in a two-record.

Volume I includes four numbers by Dorsey's famed Clambake Seven, a jazz group he used at dances, concerts and recording dates. Such numbers as "Rhythm Saved The World" and "You're A Sweetheart" demonstrate the versatility of this group. Big band arrangements of "Liebestraum" and "Loose Lid Special" are also featured as well as a vocal on "Everything Happens To Me" by a young crooner named Frank Sinatra.

In Volume II Frank Singtra is heard on five numbers. To Stafford contributes two vocals while Connie Haines and arranger Sy Oliver sing one song apiece. Many collectors items such as "March of the Toys", with its muted trumpet passages, and "Chloe" are very much in evidence. The liner notes list the complete personnel for each number. Such names as Bunny Berigan, Charlie Shavers, Ziggy Elman, Buddy Rich, Dave Tough, Bud Freeman and a host of others are well represented in the volumes.

MIDNIGHT FOR TWO The Three Suns

Here are The Three Suns, plus vibes, strings, drum and piano, and in addition, the mighty music of the pipe organ.

The Three Suns have been RCA Victor recording artists since 1947 and throughout their years of recording have been consistent in the fine quality of their music. Their imagination and refreshing sound assure

pleasant listening. They are one of the largest selling groups in the field, basing their popularity on the distinctive sound of their combination of guitar, electric organ and accordion. In their latest release, the RCA Victor album, Midnight For Two, they have added the artistry of Ray Bohr at the pipe organ of the Paramount Theater, New York City.

Again The Three Suns combine new songs with the older familiar standards. The album title song, "Midnight For Two", was written for the group by Sid Ramin, who also did the arranging. "Intermission Time", another original, was composed by Morty Nevins, the group's accordionist. The beautiful "Blue Tango" and "Stella By Starlight" are among the 12 tunes in Midnight For Two.

THE BIG, BIG, BALLAD

"Look Homeward Angel" is a big, big ballad which Johnnie Ray sings over a haunting rhythmic background, provided by Ray Connill's pen, orchestra and chorus. Johnnie's singing has taken on new fire, kindled, in part, by that 1,000,000-plus success, "Just Walking In The Rain."

The flip side is a Marty Robbins country tune, "You Don't Owe Me A Thing." Features a song about half-way between "Just Walking" and "Singing the Blues" complete with whistling a country blues beat, a knockedout Conniff arrangement, a gone set of lyrics, and — natch — an interpretation to match.

SAGA OF SHERRY

Special lyrics for The Story of Sherry sung by Don Cherry were provided by Don Cherry's wife, Sherry, one of the prettiest of all the Miss Americas. A lovely waltz refrain that has been a favorite in Europe for more than live years now, "TSOS" is very much in the style of "Autumn Leaves." "Give Me More" is also an import originally "Donnez Moi Tout Ca" that gains considerably in Don's translation, aided by Ray Conniff's handiwork with orchestra.

Last January Audrey Armstrong was a home economist at General Electric. Barbara Teffrey was a housewife with two little kids. Joyce Weston was a secretary at U.S. Steel.
