"THE BLUES IS AN OLD, OLD STORY"

Jo Stafford recreates an old but vivid story in her latest album, "Ballad of the Blues." Original lyrics by Marilyn Keith and Alan Bergman, New Orleans street cries, laments, work songs, mountain ditties and Negro splituals are skillfully woven into a panorama of the blues.

Assisted by Paul Weston's orchestra and original music, and The Starllters, Do Stafford recounts the origin of the blues in Part I, "The Blues Is an Old, Old Story." Part II, "The Blues Is a Tale of Trouble," moves to the city, where the tempo changes but the trouble remains, Part III, "The Blues Is a Travelious Thing, "tells of the mountain folk, particularly blue." He so that the particularly blue. "He's Come Away." Part IV, "Times Change and Things Change," relterates that, however streamlined and sophisticated they become, the blues are still songs of trouble.
