LOURDES, FRANCE: This world-famous more than 2,000,000 pligrims, was photographed for the first time this week for a feature motion picture, when permission was granted for the Fred Zinnemann production, "Behold a Pale Horse," to film scenes with Gregory Peck, Marietto Angeletti, Raymond Pellegrin and Paolo Stoppa.

Documentaries, short subjects and television segments have been made here previously, but no feature has been filmed on the grounds. Three units supervised by chief cameraman Jean Badal filmed from the ramps between the Church of the Rosary and the upper Basilica. Hand-held cameras then filmed the procession along the Allees de l'Esplanade and the Place du Rosaire, to the Grotto of the Virgin.

Elliott Silverstein has been signed by Columbia Pictures to make his debut as a director of feature, films, it has been announced.

Silverstein will check on the lot August 1 to direct. "There Must Be a Pony," which will be based on the best-selling novel by James Kirkwood, Jr. Published last year by Little, Brown, "There Must Be a Pony" deals with the emotional relationship of a 16-year-old boy and his oft-divorced mother. The highly dramatic story takes place in present-day Southern California.

Silverstein, one of the best-known and highly-acclaimed young directors of television dramas, has directed many of the "Dr. Kildare" series in Hollywood and "The Defenders" series in New York. When he checks in at Columbia next month he will work closely with the screenplay writer, who will be assigned shortly.

Producer-director William Castle has signed Diane Baker for a top role in his Joan Crawford starrer, "Strait-Jacket," suspense shocker which has started filming for Columbia Pictures release.

Miss Baker has just completed a co-starring role with Paul Newman in "The Prize" at MGM, an assignment which won her a longterm, non-exclusive contract with that studio.

In "Strait-Jacket," a William Castle production, the young actress will play Joan Crawford's daughter, a girl who tries to reconcile her mother's past with her own future.

The first picture is "Three on a Couch," a gay romantic comedy, which will be produced by Irving Pincus, with whom Columbia recently set an independent production deal. Robert Ross has checked in at Columbia to do a polish job on the screenplay prepared by Arne Sultan and Marvin Worth, who are busy on other commitments and not available at this time.


