Although they stoutly resist categorization as a jazz and or any other type quartet, The Hi-Lo's happily turn most of their attention and latest album to the jazz idiom—they surround themselves as well with some notable jazz musicians, such as baritone saxophonist Bud Shank, trumpeter Jack Sheldon, alto saxophonist Herb Geller, tenor saxophonist Bill Perkins, drummer Mel Lewis.

MALAGUENA . . . An instrumental profile of Cuba by one of its most ardent North American admirers, Maestro Percy Faith. Arranged and performed in characteristically dazzling Faith fashion, the medley is drawn, for the most part, from the catalogue of Cuba's leading composer, Ernesto Lecuona—Malaguena . . . Siboney . . Andalucia . . La Cumparsa. Special attention is focused on the ballroom dance rhythms of Cuban origin, with all the major dances represented in the collection—rhumba, samba, conga. guaracha, and that reigning favorite, cha-cha-cha.

SENTIMENTAL AND SWINGING ...

Columbia dedicates a Tommy and Jimmy Dorsey album, last of the unreleased Dorsey Brothers' recordings, to what album annotator-producer Irving Townsend describes as "the generation between the lost generation of the Twenties and the beat generation of the Fifties which might be called the big-band generation." Herewith Tommy's last band. heard with drummer Buddy Rich, who was leaving the organization at the time the recordings were made, and his successor, Louis Bellson, Also performing in the ensemble are trumpeters Lee Castle. Charlie Shavers, and the late Andy Ferretti. One "Lp" side is devoted to the sentimental ballads Tommy Dorsey made his particular property, the other to the driving, big-band sound he championed.




































































