A WEIGHTY MATTER

Police of a fair-sized city in the southwest gave the horse-laugh to a burglar, who had carted a 200-pound cash register out of a local laundry. EARLY SCIENCE SLEUTHING

In England, in 1909, one Colonel Pilcher was dismayed to learn that as executor of an unsigned will by a Miss Kerferd, he was to get a pittance while her relatives were to inherit a

sizeable sum.

In rummaging through the deceased's belongings, some time later, he found an old signed will, which gave him prior claim to the estate. When the court ruled that this was valid, the fortune went to the Colonel. In a few years, he spent it all.

Meanwhile, a relative of Miss Kerferd, who all along suspected the will had been faked, turned for aid to a chemist-friend. He analyzed the ink allegedly used by the deceased, and came up with the startling information that the signature had been affixed after her death! The will was a forgery!

Faced with this evidence, Colonel Pilcher confessed. Since this was his first offense, the fortune had been squandered, and the Colonel was almost 70, the court was sympathetic towards his plea for leniency. He was sentenced

to a couple of years.

FOWL PLAY

Now it's the chicken thief who's turned to science. In Melbourne, Australia, it was reported that thieves sprayed ether into the coops to silence the hens, who usually created an uproar when their henhouses were invaded. Police were certain of capturing the fowl-nappers.

BLOTTER JOTTINGS
