The makers of the country's pills, capsules, and tablets are asking Federal authorities for an assist in putting a halt to a new wrinkle in counterfeiting, which is not only endangering their one billion dollars a year business but also the health of the nation. Frowning on such practices, the government issues severe jail sentences and levies enormous fines when persons are found guilty of making substitutions.

Whenever a new capsule or tablet becomes a popular drug store item, crime takes a hand in the pillrolling. Capsules are oblong, and are comprised of two pieces of well-fitted gelatin which hold. a powder. Pills are usually round, and rolled by hand from a mass, while tabets are flat and produced from powder via a compression machine.

One chemical house, the Arner Company, of Buffalo, N. Y., is taking steps to thwart these pharmaceutical phonies. While no manufacturer can actually stop these imitators in duplicating such exterior appearances as color, shape, and size, Arner ingenuity has perfected a method of identification which is as foolproof as fingerprints.

From secret dyes, coatings are made and applied to the tops of the pills. The ingredients of these dyes are kept highly secret in order to prevent any attempt at duplication. Then, the usual coating is put directly over the dye.

How are fakes detected? Whenever medicaments are suspected, they are checked via a spectrophotometer, whose ultra-violet rays penetrate the outer coating and analyze the materials.

The popularity of tablets, pills, and capsules has increased the number of medical mounte-

banks, but what with one device or another, legitimate manufacturers have been able to balk them at every turn.

HE GETS HIS CAR!

From Flushing N. Y., Ray Barnes masterminds a network of car cops who reclaim almost 3,000 automobiles a year. Founder and chief sleuth of the Automobile Recovery Bureau—a unique organization, which was begun some years after World War I—he directs its activities which entail hunting down man and machine.

Barnes' clients are finance and insurance firms and banks, which are eager to reposses the automobiles when "buyers" have defaulted payment. His quarry is not the average motorist who finds that he is unable to meet an installment and genuinely promises to do so when he can. All his attention is directed at the thief who obtains a vehicle by offering false information to finance it.

State laws support Barnes' actions. Until a car is completely paid for, they read, it remains the legal property of the firm which finances it. Thus, Barnes has the right to interfere with a car-snatch so long as he does not violate anyone's Constitutional right, like breaking into his home.

When Barnes is brought into a case, first thing he does is call the motor vehicle bureau for the license number. Next, he visits the fugitive's home, then begins to piece together his clues much like any other detective during an investigation.

Usually, the case is quite simple. Barnes, after some careful deduction, is able to repossess the missing car at a parking lot or on the street.

But sometimes more heady work is required. For instance, not long ago, a car that was driven across country from California was picked up in New Jersey.

Ninety per cent of the missing machines are reclaimed within a couple of months. One case took exactly 20 minutes, but, on the other hand, four years were needed to crack another.

His operatives are constantly combing the country. Occasionally, his wife also steps in to lend a hand. An Oklahoman by birth, shortly after the first World War, in which he served in the Navy, Barnes went to work for an automobile insurance company. It wasn't long before he realized the necessity for a private auto eye, and he set up his own business, which has been flourishing since.

FORGER FREED

A man caught in the act of trying to pass a forged check in an Alabama bank prepared himself for the maximum jail sentence when brought to trial. Even his attorney didn't hold out much hope. But then, justice took an ironic turn. The judge asked the court clerk to hand him the evidence for examination. Glancing at the check in question, His Honor dismissed the proceedings and discharged the accused,

What had prompted this strange action? According to the judge, Alabama law does not recognize any centract written on Sunday. Since the check was dated on that day, it was not valid. Hence, no forgery was involved.

DOUBLE BULLET CASE

Roger Jarrett and Horace Blandings graduated from a mid-western college and came to the big city to make their mark in the world. They were inseparable companions, as their neighbors in the east side apartment house where they shared a flat, testified later. Then, abruptly, one night, they overheard a violent quarrel between the two men, which was punctuated by a pistol shot.

Police found Blandings' body slumped in a chair, his right arm flung over its back. Further probing yielded two bullets in the corpse and the murder weapon, behind a chest of drawers. To Jarrett's persistent explanation that Blandings had pulled the gun from his pocket—during a quarrel involving a girl they had both been dating—and had committed suicide, cynical po-

lice posed two questions? How could a man pump two bullets into himself if he wanted to kill himself, and then how could he hide the gun before he dropped into the chair to die?

Even Jarrett was dazed by this circumstantial evidence. He was arrested and indicted. While Jarrett awaited trial, the coroner, who had discovered the two bullets, remained mystified by the presence of only one bullet hole in the corpse. For some time, he studied the odd shapes of the bullets in his gloomy headquarters office, and one day, shortly before the trial was to begin, he presented to the District Attorney his theory and unquestionable evidence which was subsequently to free Roger Jarrett.

The first bullet, fired some time previously had been stuck in the barrel. When Blandings squeezed the trigger the night of the alleged murder, it was ejected with the first. Both traveled in the same direction—into Blandings.

And how had the pistol been deposited behind the chest of drawers? The coroner could explain that, too. The gas, which had become obstructed when the first shot jammed, produced a recoil powerful enough to wrench the weapon from Blandings' hand and hurl it behind the chest of drawers!
