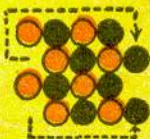
MAGIC TRICKS

TABLES TURNED

Any policeman who has served for a number of years can tell a strange story of his own experience, but perhaps the strangest of all can be narrated by the members of an upper New York City precinct, who were involved a few years ago in a rash of holdups committed by a lone thief. The bandit was finally caught, and the whole matter would have followed a routine pattern—arraignment, trial and sentence—except for one, solitary, maddening thing: not one of his victims would identify him!

Hour after hour, storekeepers who had trembled at the sight of this homicidal miscreant, who had threatened them with an automatic if they didn't turn over their cash register receipts, refused to recognize him. The lights in the lineup room grew hot, but not as much as the tempers of the arresting officers and the detectives. It was all too obvious to them that the shopkeepers were intimidated, afraid of the consequences when the thief ultimately would be released from jail. Accusation meant death at his hands.

One of the detectives slipped off his jacket and motioned the others to do the same. "We're going to keep at this again and again until we get a positive identification. This mugg is our man, and we're going to keep questioning these people until one admits having been robbed by him!"

The frightened storekeepers were herded into the stuffy room, and the detective faced them grimly.

"Now, listen! None of you has to be afraid. The law will protect you. The only thing one of you has to do is say that he's the robber, and you can all go home," he pleaded, in a harsh, strained voice.

But the group paid him no heed. The detective's voice spiraled into a shout. "Okay, if that's how you want it, we'll keep at it right through the night and into the next day, if necessary. I'm warning you! Now, will one of you—"

But he was interrupted by the culprit himself who stepped to the rim of the rostrum, out of the glare, wiping his moist forehead. "Look, I don't know about you folks out there, but I'm gettin' tired standin' up here, fryin'. So look, lieutenant, if they're clammin' up, why don't you let me finger them? Then, we can all knock off!"

And before the astonished officer could splutter a reply, the thief crooked a finger at one of his pale victims, and added: "You remember me, don't you? I took your tailor shop for \$55 on a Saturday night. It was the last of the month, and you said you needed the dough to meet some checks."

To another: "I'm the guy who came into your butcher store and asked for hamburger meat. When you went to get it outta the ice-box, I locked you in and cleaned out your register."

To a third: "I got 38 smackers from your candy store. It was as easy as takin' candy from a baby."

And so it went, the complete confession

with details down to the last dime. After a while, when each of the victims present had been accounted for, the lineup room was cleared, the tormented shopowners went home, and the weary thief was led away to a cell to await trial.

BOOTLEG FISH

If you're driving north from Florida, don't be surprised if game wardens ask you to pause so that they can comb your car at the Georgia border. The reason behind this act is their search for illicit cargo, fresh-water game fish scooped up illegally from Florida's lakes.

Bootlegged fish pose a constant problem for the state's Game and Fresh Water Commission who not only must protect their charges for sportsmen but also must keep the population of each lake constant.

Bootleggers—or fishnappers, to be more exact—don't bother to catch each fish individually with a hook. Countless wriggling thousands are netted by the hour. The fish then are packed in ice. Stored in the rear of sedans, rather than trucks which would naturally be suspected, the fish are covered with canvas to escape detection. On the road, occasional stops are made to drain the melted ice.

Black-market dealers in Georgia pay between \$350 and \$400 for a load, with supply and demand causing the price fluctuation. But catching the culprits is not easy. Once, investigators had to pursue an operator for a hundred miles. The wild chase ended when they shot out his tires. It was quite a catch—800 pounds of speckled perch and bream.

FELON FAILURE

A Chicago burglar ran the gamut of hard luck one night not so long ago when he tried to pry open a tailor shop but only succeeded in setting off a burglar alarm. Next, he tried a restaurant in the neighborhood, but he was stopped by a jimmy-proof door. Lured by the swollen receipts of a hit show playing in a local theatre, he got into the boxoffice in the morning's early hours but failed to crack the safe.

Completely frustrated by his abortive efforts, he telephoned the police. "You can ar-

rest me for attempted robbery. Come down and get me," he sobbed.

It was his sole effort that met with success. In mere seconds, a squad car was bearing down in his direction.
