### STRANGE SLAYING

What do you think is the most bizarre killing of all time?

Well, homicide historians who have studied the subject for years have finally concluded that it occurred on a small island in the Mediterranean many centuries ago. Romeo and Italo were business partners; while Romeo fished in the sea, Italo remained on land, selling the catch.

Away almost all day, Romeo had the utmost confidence in his partner, but over the years, he failed to understand how Italo could amass wealth enough to build a new home, buy a stable of horses, and grow fat with contentment.

He decided to investigate. Finally, his suspicions were confirmed. Italo had not shared equally with him. He had pocketed the bulk of their profits. Witnesses swore to the sums they had paid him.

Romeo's rage was uncontrollable. Then, one morning, the island's natives were shocked by a spectacle that made them cringe with horror. Tied to one of the whirring blades of the tallest windmill on the isle was Italo. As they rushed up to the rescue, they noted that he obviously was dead, for beads of blood from knife wounds formed a pattern on the sand.

While Romeo confessed to the killing,

police were reluctant to arrest him. But one day soon after, perhaps filled with remorse and flayed by his conscience, Romeo boarded his fishing craft and sailed out to sea, never to return again.

#### COP IN THE CAST

Any time the University of Minnesota Theatre finds that it has to cast a policeman in one of its plays, it doesn't have to look further than its own drama students. For 27-year-old Wayne Hartley has been walking a beat for five years.

### EXIT THE EXECUTIONER

The Federal Prison Bureau has some good news. There were less executions in the United States in 1953 than in any year since 1930, when accurate records were begun to be kept. Only 62 death sentences were carried out, 20 fewer than in 1950, the previous low year. The record high of 199 was set in 1935. Since 1930, the annual average was 140.

## STATION C-A-P

A tiny radio set is concealed inside the officer's cap.
