THE FIGHTING VILLAGE

At about two o'clock, the two companions they had left back at the restaurant, Cole Younger and Clel Miller, came riding up Division Street. As they neared the First National Bank, James and his two companions stood up, strolled down Division Street, and entered the bank.

This was Miller's signal to stride up to the bank and close its door. Cole Younger pretended to be busy adjusting the saddle girth on his horse.

This was it! Town after town had fallen prey to the carefully-planned but

lightning raids of the Younger-James gang. And those towns whose banks had not yet been ransacked by the terrifying bank robbers, shuddered in fear at the very mention of their names.

But Northfield was not the kind of town that scared easily.

Seconds after Miller closed, the bank's door, a local merchant by the name of J. S. Allen walked up toward the bank to make a deposit. Miller grabbed him, ordering him to stand back.

Far from being frightened, Allen pushed the outlaw away, and headed for his store, shouting, "Get your guns, boys—they're robbing the bank!"

For the time being, Jesse and his brother Frank had outrun the law. Sooner or later, they would both stop being threats to law-abiding citizens.

The important thing was, the James boys were never the same. The Northfield National Bank was the last bank they ever tried to rob.

And Northfield went back to its sleepy ways, unmindful of the great courage its citizens had displayed.


