
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













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
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
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
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
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
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


































Hi Fans!






















































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
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

















BAT-JOKES FOR JERRY

Why is Batman like an adding machine? You can count on both, says Jeff Williamson of Chillicothe. Ohio.


How was the little bat boy punished? asks Christ Metris of San Mateo, Calif. He was spanked on his batside!

And, finally, as if you didn't know, the bats' favorite sport, remarks Gabriel Tirado of New York City, would be batsketball!



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




