> LONG AND COSTLY WAR. IN APRIL, 1868, A PEACE WAS DECLARED AND ALL SOLDIERS WERE REMOVED FROM FORTS SMITH, RENO, AND KEARNY. RED CLOUD NOW BELIEVED THAT HE HAD WON BACK THE HUNT-ING GROUNDS FOR HIS PEOPLE, BUT THE FOLLOW-ING TEN YEARS PROVED THAT HE WAS WRONG. HE DIED IN 1909. IT IS BELIEVED THAT HE WAS ALMOST NINETY-YEARS-OLD.
