MORE POWER FOR OLD TIME RADIO! That's the BIG NEWS for June, as we begin another series of vintage radio broadcasts every day, Monday thru Friday, from 3 to 5 p.m. on FM radio station WXFM. You'll find WXFM at 106 on your FM dial, and we'll have 50,000 watts of FM power transmitting from the highest point in Chicagoland, the top of the Sears Tower!

The afternoon edition of THE HALL CLOSET will feature the good old shows, interviews, music, comedy, trivia and special features. And, with all that Power from the Tower, we'll be heard throughout Metropolitan Chicago. The WXFM signal reaches from the Sears Tower to Kenosha, Kankakee, Rockford and Gary...and everywhere in between!

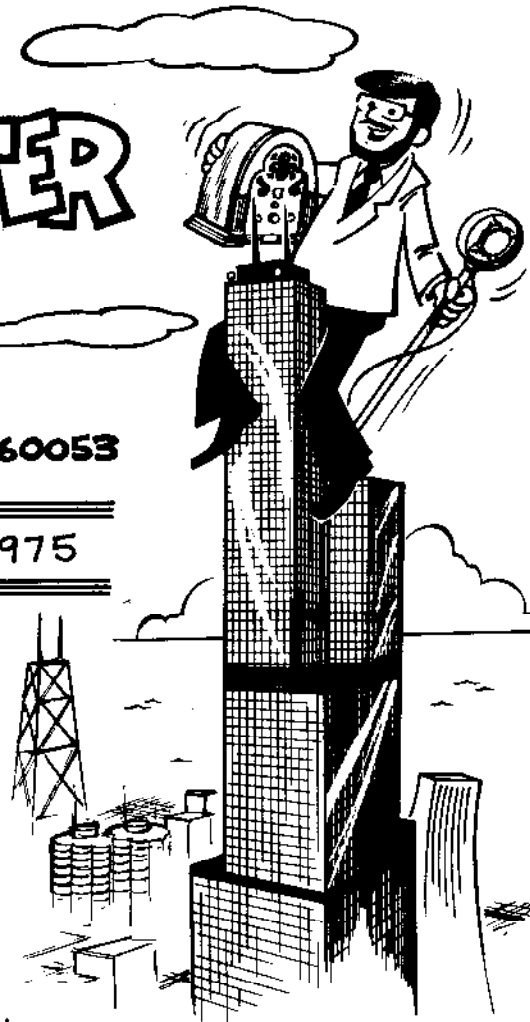
WXFM's programming features serious music throughout the night and into the morning, Count B.J. with Sinatra-style easy listening sounds, Broadway Show Music, Bruce DuMont's Montage (Mon-Fri, 2-3 p.m.), Dick Lawrence and music from the 1920s, plus TRIAD, progressive sounds in the evening hours. The complete schedule of our new WXFM HALL CLOSET for the month of June is listed inside, and you'll note that our afternoon shows on WXFM will be different from our morning shows on WLTD.

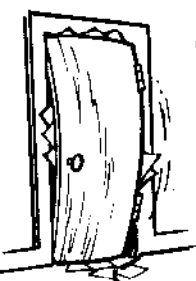
You'll also see that we are continuing to provide vintage radio on WBEZ, WTAQ and WAIT as well as on WLTD and WXFM. But wait! We're adding STILL ANOTHER spot on the dial to do our thing.

Beginning on Sunday, June 1st, we'll have two hours of OLD TIME RADIO AND ALL THAT JAZZ on northwest suburban Arlington Heights FM radio station WWMM, 92.7 on your dial. We'll find lots to add to WWMM's Oasis of Jazz as we schedule Big Band remotes, studio music shows and vintage musicomedy broadcasts. Join us every Sunday evening from 7 to 9 p.m. on WWMM. 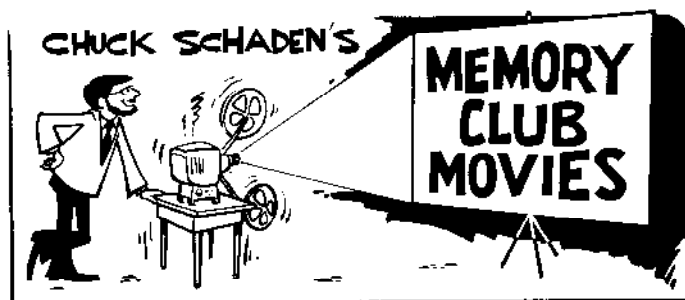

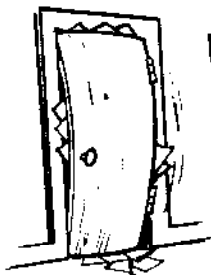
