





Ow wah!", "Buzz me, Miss Blue." and "Check and double check." Amos 'n' Andy ran the Fresh-Air Taxi and belonged to the Mystic Knights of the Sea of which George Stevens was "The Kingfish." One of the most famous sequences was the time Andy almost married Madame Queen.




