## REMEMBER RADIO



THIS IS A LIST OF RADIO PROGRAMS THAT HAVE BEEN COLLECTED OVER A LONG PERIOD OF TIME. ORIGINALLY, RADIO SHOWS WERE RECORDED ON LARGE 16 INCH ACETATE DISCS. WHEN THE SOUND IS TRANSFERRED TO TAPE, THE QUALITY CAN VARY GREATLY BECAUSE THESE DISCS WERE NOT PROTECTED BY THE RADIO STATIONS OR NETWORKS. WE HAVE TRIED TO SET UP A SYSTEM TO GRADE THE SOUND QUALITY ON MOST SHOWS LISTED: HOWEVER, QUALITY IS AN INDIVIDUAL THING AND VARIES FROM INDIVIDUAL TO INDIVIDUAL. OUR SHOWS RANGE FROM PERFECT SOUND TO VERY POOR. MOST ARE IN THE VG OR VG/G RANGE. VG-THE SOUND IS PERFECT OR HAS A MINOR PROBLEM THAT IS NOT VERY BAD. G-THERE IS A MAJOR PROBLEM, SUCH AS BAD HUM, CROSS TALK, HOLLOW SOUND, MUFFLED, FAST, SLOW, DIPS IN SOUND, OR ANY OTHER MAJOR PROBLEM BUT THE SHOW CAN BE UNDERSTOOD WITH VARING DEGREES OF DIFFICULTY. F & P-SOUND IS TERRIBLE, BUT IF YOU ARE A REAL NUT ON THAT SHOW YOU CAN STILL GET SOMETHING OUT OF IT. YOU WILL NOTICE THAT MANY SHOWS ARE RATED VG/G OR G/F. THESE MEAN THAT THE SHOW IS IN THE MIDDLE OF THESE TWO, SO (TO MY EAR) A VG/G IS NOT HAVE A RATING FOR THE SHOW (OR SHOWS) YOU TAKE A CHANCE ON THE SOUND QUALITY. JUST BECAUSE IT IS NOT RATED, DOES NOT HAVE A RATING FOR THE SHOW (OR SHOWS) YOU TAKE A CHANCE ON THE SOUND QUALITY. JUST BECAUSE IT IS NOT RATED, DOES NOT MEAN THAT IT IS BAD NOR THE OPPOSITE. PLEASE DO NOT ORDER ONE OR EVEN TWO REELS AND JUDGE THE COLLECTION FROM THESE. YOU MIGHT BE LUCKY AND GET AN EXCELLENT REEL OR UNLUCKY AND GET ONE THAT IS NOT VERY GOOD. SO WHEN CHOOSING A REEL, LOOK AT THE SOUND VALUES AS WELL AS THE NAME OF THE SHOWS. IF YOU CHOOSE A REEL WHERE MOST OF THE SHOWS ARE RATED G/VG YOU CAN EXPECT SOME SOUND PROBLEMS. IF YOU HAPPEN TO GET A REEL THAT APPEARS TO BAD BECAUSE OF A FAULT IN MY RECORDERS WRITTE US BEFORE SENDING BACK THE TAPE AND EXPLAIN THE PROBLEM, WHICH REEL NUMBER IS INVOLVED, AND PLEASE GIVE THE TWO NUMBERS WRITTEN INSIDE THE BOX.

MY COMPANY SELLS SHOWS BY THE REEL. IN OTHER WORDS, YOU CHOOSE A WHOLE REEL OF SHOWS AND YOU GET ALL THE SHOWS LISTED. THIS SAVES YOU MONEY AND US TIME. MANY COMPANIES SELL BY THE HOUR AND CHARGE UP TO \$10.00 OR EVEN \$20.00 PER HOUR, BUT YOU GET TO CHOOSE EACH HOUR. THEY SEND YOU A FANCY CATALOG AND CHARGE \$1.00 FOR THEIR CATALOG (WHICH IS REFUNDABLE), BUT MOST PEOPLE CAN'T AFFORD \$10.00 PER HOUR AND AT OUR PRICES WE CAN'T AFFORD TO REFUND THE 50¢ FOR THE CATALOG. SO,

IF YOU HAVE A FRIEND WHO WANTS A CATALOG, PLEASE ASK HIM TO SEND US 50¢ IN STAMPS OR COIN.

BE SURE AND ADD 25¢ FOR EACH REEL THAT YOU WANT INSURED. THAT IS 25¢ FOR EACH REEL. THE LOCAL POSTOFFICE TELLS US THAT IF A REEL IS LOST, THEY WILL ONLY PAY THE VALUE OF THE BLANK REEL AND NOT THE PRICE YOU PAY FOR THE REEL. HENCE, I HAVE DECIDED TO INSURE EACH REEL MYSELF AND GUARANTEE THAT THE LOST REELS WILL BE REPLACED. THE NUMBER OF LOST OR STOLEN REELS HAS RISEN TO AN ALARMING NUMBER. EACH MONTH THE POSTOFFICE SEEMS TO GET WORSE AND MORE AND MORE REELS ARE LOST. SO YOU SHOULD SPEND THE SMALL AMOUNT OF 25¢ TO BE SURE YOU RECEIVE WHAT YOU HAVE PURCHASED. IF YOU HAVE NOT PAID FOR INSURANCE AND THE TAPES ARE LOST IN THE MAILS, YOU WILL SIMPLY LOOSE YOU MONEY AND THE TAPES. I WILL NOT REPLACE TAPES WHICH WERE NOT INSURED. ALSO, IF YOU SEND ONLYEMOUGH MONEY TO INSURE PART OF AN ORDER, THEN ONLY THAT PART WILL BE INSURED AND REPLACED. ALL REELS ARE SENT OUT SPECIAL 4TH CLASS WITH SPECIAL HANDLING ADDED. THIS MEANS THAT THEY GO WITH FIRST CLASS MAIL. IF YOU WANT OR NEED AIR MAIL SEE THE PRICES ABOVE. PEOPLE WITH APO, FPO ADDRESSES, OR PEOPLE IN ALASKA, CANADA, ETC. MAY NEED AIRMAIL POSTAGE. PERSONS WITH FOREIGN ADDRESSES WILL SURELY NEED AIR MAIL AND SHOULD WRITE FOR COSTS OF POSTAGE TO THEIR COUNTRY.

ALL TAPES ARE 7 INCH REELS (WE CANNOT SELL ON 5 INCH OR 3 INCH) 1800 FT. TAPES. THE SPEED FOR 99% OF THE REELS IS 3 3/4. IF IT IS 7½ IT WILL BE NOTED. THE LISTED REELS VARY FROM 4 HOURS TO 6 HOURS, BUT THE AVERAGE IS ABOUT 5½ HOURS. IF YOU ORDER A REEL STEREO YOU WILL GET A TAPE WITH ALL FOUR OF THE RECORDING CHANNELS FILLED. EACH OF THE FOUR WILL HAVE SEPARATE PROGRAMS AND WILL BE PLAYED SEPARATELY. IF YOU HAVE AN OLDER MACHINE THAT CANNOT GIVE YOU STEREO MUSIC YOU WILL RECEIVE TWO TAPES INSTEAD OF ONE FOR EACH OF THE CATALOG REELS YOU ORDER. IN OTHER WORDS, IT TAKES TWICE AS MUCH TAPE AND TWICE AS MUCH TIME FOR US TO RECORD ½ TRACK AS IT DOES 4 TRACK. THIS IS THE REASON FOR THE ADDED COST OF THESE TAPES. ALL TAPES ARE POLYESTER LUBRICATED TAPES THAT WILL NOT DAMAGE YOUR RECORDER HEADS. WE USE NEW TAPE THAT HAS NEVER BEEN USED OR ERASED. MY MACHINES ARE TANDBERGS WHICH ARE MADE IN NORWAY. THEY ARE VERY GOOD MACHINES AND GIVE GOOD REPRODUCTION

DAYS FROM THE DATE I RECEIVE YOUR ORDER UNTIL I HAVE THE TAPES BACK IN THE MAIL TO YOU. THE TIME VARIES ACCORDING TO THE NUMBER OF ORDER, TRADES, TAPE RECORDER REPAIRS, HOLIDAYS, POSTAL STRIKES, ETC. THESE TAPES ARE NOT ALREADY MADE UP AND READY FOR SHIPPING. YOUR ORDER COMES IN, WE ENTER IT INTO OUR BOOKS, PUT YOUR ORDER UNDER A STACK OF ORDERS ALREADY RECEIVED AND IT WORKS TO THE TOP. WHEN IT GETS TO THE TOP, IT IS FILLED AS THE MACHINES CAN TAPE THE TAPE, IS BOXED AND SENT OUT.

SUPERMAN, TERRY & THE PIRATES, HOP HARRIGAN, AND MANY, MANY MORE. DISCS CAN BE FOUND ALMOST ANYWHERE. WHY NOT TRY AND FIND
A FEW. PERHAPS YOU LOCAL RADIO STATION HAS SOME STORED OR IF YOU KNOW SOME ENGINEER, ACTOR, ETC. IN THE TV, RADIO OR
MOVIE FIELDS HE MAY KNOW WHERE DISCS MAY BE LOCATED.

ALL OF THIS IS DUE TO A THREAT BY MR. CHARLES MICHELSON OF <u>CHARLES MICHELSON</u>, <u>INC</u>. THAT HE WOULD SUE ME FOR COPYRIGHT INFRINGMENT IF I DID NOT STOP SELLING THE PROGRAMS HE CLAIMS TO OWN. MANY OF THESE REELS HAVE ONLY ONE OR TWO PROGRAMS ON THEM THAT MR. MICHELSON CLAIMS. SOME SEEM TO BE MADE UP COMPLETELY OF SHOWS HE CLAIMS. I AM TRYING TO DETERMINE WHICH IF ANY, OF THE SHOWS HE CLAIMS ARE REALLY OWNED BY HIM. MANY OF THESE REELS WILL TURN UP AGAIN WITH THE OFFENDING PROGRAMS SURGICALLY REMOVED FROM THE REEL. MR. MICHELSON CLAIMS THAT WHEN REMEMBER RADIO SELLS ONE OF THESE PROGRAMS, HE IS BEING GREATLY DAMAGED AND THE VALUE OF THE PROGRAM REDUCED. HE SEEMS TO FEEL THAT THE PUBLIC SHOULD ONLY BE ABLE TO HEAR SUCH PROGRAMS AS <u>FIBBER McGEE</u> & MOLLY, <u>LONE RANGER</u>, <u>SHADOW</u>, ETC, ETC. IF AND WHEN THEY APPEAR ON A LOCAL RADIO STATION IN YOUR AREA AND NOT SOONER. I FEEL THAT THE INTEREST IN THESE PROGRAMS ARE MAINLY GENERATED BY THE SELLING AND TRADING OF PROGRAMS BETWEEN INDIVIDUALS. I FEEL THAT MANY RADIO STATIONS THAT NOW PAY MR. MICHELSON FOR THE RIGHT TO BROADCAST SOME OF HIS PROGRAMS WOULD NOT HAVE HAD THE INTEREST EXCEPT FOR THE FACT THAT PEOPLE LIKE YOURSELVES DECIDED TO INVEST YOUR TIME AND MONEY IN TAPES OF OLD RADIO SHOWS. IF YOU AGREE WITH MR. MICHELSON THEN YOU SHOULD WHITE HIM AND TELL HIM SO. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE THEN WHY NOT WRITE AND TELL HIM WHY. HIS ADDRESS IS: CHARLES MICHELSON INC., 45 WEST 45TH ST, NEW YORK, N.Y., 10036. WHETHER OR NOT MR. MICHELSON KNOWS IT OR NOT, SEVERAL RADIO STATIONS THAT NOW USE HIS PROGRAMS WERE SENT TO HIM BY REMEMBER RADIO, INC. THESE STATIONS CONTACTED ME TO ASK THAT I SELL THEM SHOWS TO BROADCAST AND I SUGGESTED THAT THEY CONTACT MICHELSON FOR PROGRAMS. THEY HAD NOT HEARD OF CHARLES MICHELSON UNTIL I TOLD THEM OF HIS

THIS NEW LISTING YOU SEE BEFORE YOU WOULD HAVE HAD AN EXTRA 22 REELS OF SUCH SHOWS AS FIBBER MCGEE & MOLLY EXCEPT FOR THE INTERVENTION OF MR. MICHELSON. THERE ARE MANY GOOD SHOWS LEFT, BUT YOU HAD BETTER HURRY. MICHELSON IS BUYING UP THE RIGHTS AS FAST AS HE CAN AND WE MAY SOMEDAY NOT HAVE ENOUGH SHOWS LEFT TO PUT OUT A CATALOG. I JUST HOPE THAT MICHELSON DOES PUT ON THE AIR SOME OF THE SHOWS HE CLAIMS TO OWN. MANY OF THESE HE SEEMS TO BE SITTING ON ARE SUCH SHOWS AS: GREAT GILDERSLEEVE, CHANDU THE MAGACIAN, CHICK CARTER, NICK CARTER, SUPERMAN, ETC., ETC.

A STATEMENT ABOUT SOUND QUALITY. NINETY-EIGHT PERCENT OF THE PROGRAMS YOU SEE ON MY LIST AND THE LISTS OF OTHER DEALERS COME FROM 16 INCH DISCS. THE PERSON OWNING THE DISCS RECORDS THE DISC ONTO TAPE. THIS RECORDING IS CALLED A FIRST GENERATION COPY. IT IS THE NEAREST ONE TO THE ACTUAL SOURCE. WHEN A COPY IS MADE OF THE TAPE (NOT THE DISC) THEN THIS IS A SECOND GENERATION COPY, NEXT OF COURSE, IS A THIRD GENERATION, FOURTH, AND SO ON TO INFINITY. THE IMPORTANT THING TO REMEMBER IS THAT EACH TIME A COPY IS MADE OF A COPY AND EACH TIME YOU GET ONE STEP FURTHER FROM THE ORIGINAL DISC, YOU LOSE SOME QUALITY. THE QUALITY IS NEVER ENHANCED, ONLY LOWERED. THUS, IT IS BETTER TO GET AS CLOSE TO THE ORIGINAL DISC AS POSSIBLE. REMEMBER RADIO TRIES, IF POSSIBLE, TO OWN THE DISC OR AT LEAST HAVE OUR COPIES MADE FROM THE ORIGINAL DISC. WE OFTEN THROW OUT COPIES OF PROGRAMS THAT ARE SIMPLY TOO BAD FOR US TO SELL. THIS LOWERING OF SOUND QUALITY IS WHY YOU MAY BUY EXACTLY THE SAME PROGRAM FROM TWO DIFFERENT DEALERS AND GET A GOOD AND A BAD SOUNDING PROGRAM. I HAVE FIVE COPIES OF ONE AMOS & ANDY SHOW. EACH COPY IS DIFFERENT IN SOUND FROM THE OTHER FOUR. THE SOUND RANGES FROM NEAR PERFECT TO COMPLETELY HORRIBLE. THE REASON BEING THAT THE BEST SOUNDING COPY CAME FROM THE DISC AND THE WORST ONE PROBABLY WAS ABOUT 75 COPIES AWAY. MANY OF THE PROGRAMS ON THIS NEW LIST CAME FROM THE DISCS. IN THE FUTURE WE WILL PRESENT PROGRAMS THAT ARE DIRECTLY FROM THE DISCS AND I BELIEVE YOU WILL REALLY ENJOY. WE HAVE NOW 89 JACK ARMSTRONG PROGRAMS IN CONSECUTIVE ORDER FROM SEPT. 1940 INTO MARCH 1941. WE ALSO JUST BOUGHT THE DISCS TO 174 SPEED GIBSON SHOWS, AND WE HAVE MANY SINGLE SHOWS SUCH AS THE ALDRICH FAMILY, AMOS & ANDY, ETC. LISTED HERE OR WAITING ON ANOTHER SUPPLEMENT. I COUNTED THE NUMBER OF DEALERS NOW SELLING PROGRAMS WHO RECEIVED MOST, IF NOT ALL THEIR PROGRAMS FROM REMEMBER RADIO. I WAS ASTOUNDED TO FIND THAT ONLY FIVE DEALERS WHO ADVERTISE DID NOT (I REPEAT) DID NOT GET THEIR SHOWS FROM US. THIS MEANS THAT UNLESS YOU ARE DEALING WITH ONE OF THE FIVE THAT YOUR COPIES FROM ANOTHER DEALER CANNOT POSSIBLE BE AS GOOD AS THE ONE YOU GET BY BUYING DIRECTLY FROM REMEMBER RADIO. SO THE NEXT TIME YOU SEE ANOTHER DEALER'S CATALOG WITH THE SAME SHOWS LISTED, YOU CAN BET THAT HE PROBABLY GOT THEM FROM US, AND ANY DUB FROM THEM WILL NOT BE AS GOOD AS THE ONE YOU WILL RECEIVE FROM US. SO IF YOU ARE A JACK ARMSTRONG BUFF OR A SPEED GIBSON FAN, WHY NOT GET THE BEST COPIES. WHY SETTLE FOR LESSER SOUND WHEN OUR COPIES CAME FROM THE DISCS. FUTURE LISTS WILL CARRY BOTH OF THESE SHOWS AND MANY MORE. REEL #251 BIG BAND REMOTES
