MUSIC: (UP AND SEGUE)

MANN:

That's the one. Among other things, Vaughn, I noticed that you're an amateur photographer. I revere men who like photography.

BARCLAY:

She reveres men who like photography. (UP) Ladies and Gentlemen, this is the Camel Caravan announcer, George Barclay. I wish to announce that Miss Mann's remark has no connection with the fact that she is the star of the Revere Camera Radio Show.

MONROE:

And may I say, Peggy, that you've been singing great guns lately. I know this will be a banner year for you.

BARCLAY:

Singing ... Great Guns ... Banner year. Ladies and Gentlemen, this is George Barclay again. I wish to announce that Vaughn's remark has no connection with the fact that he is making a Western picture called "Singing Guns", in which he rides a horse named Banner. Well,..I'll meet you after the show, Miss Mann.

MONROE:

George, you don't even know Peggy.

BARCLAY:

Well, I can dream, can't I?

MONROE:

Ladies and Gentlemen, I wish to ammounce that Mr. Barclay's remark has no connection with the fact that our next tune, sung by Peggy Mann, is called..."I Can Dream, Can't I". It happens to be on the "Variety" list as the number-one record request this week in Fort Worth, Texas. 5.50

As the Caravan rolls along,

The Moonmen join with Vaughn Monroe

To sing this big hit song. 8.30

BARCLAY: A short while back, Vaughn was talking to a young lady named Ann O'Rourke. She's a secretary and her home is in Long Island, New York. Here's the interview on tape:

MONROE: (ON TAPE) Hello, Ann!

O'ROURKE: Hello there, Vaughn!

MONROE: Now, Ann, toll us about your smoking test.
