MARTY: Thank you...and a great big welcome to all my friends and neighbors of the Grand Ole Opry. Grant Turner -- call am off, boy...tell the folks what's cookin' for tonight.

GRANT: Well, there's a lot of great pickin' and singin' on tap for tonight,

Marty...with Rod Brasfield! Minnie Pearl!

Del Wood! Chet Atkins! and the entire Opry gang. Then too

there's your guest, Marty.

MARTY: Yeahhhh. A pretty Texas gal who sings a fine country song -Miss Goldle Hill!

MUSIC: SQUARE DANCE . "SALLY GOODIN"

(APPLAUSE)

(INTO ACCORDIAN IN BG...)

Thank you, Goldie -- and thanks to all the Opry dancers for some real Opry fun. Right now, we all settle down for a moment or two and get to share a fine old sacred song. For all our friends of the Opry, here's "Who At My Door is Standing".

ROBBINS.. "WHO AT MY DOOR IS STANDING"

(APPLAUSE)

(MARTY OVER)

MARTY: (READ EXACTLY AS WRITTEN FOR NETWORK CUE) Thank you, folks, thanks a whole lot. Well, here comes a friend of yours with something mighty-important on his mind.
