GRANT: From the Ryman Auditorium in Nashville, Tennessee -- the country music capital of the world---here's the 937th broadcast of your Grand Ole Opry -- tonight starring--- Porter Waggoner !!
(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "PAYDAY"..... PORTER WAGGONER
(APPLAUSE)

WAGGONER: Thank you, folks...we'd like to welcome you to another Grand Ole Opry. Just make yourselves right at home and enjoy.....

GRANT: ... Rod Brasfield ! the Jordanaïres.....Chet Atkins..... Del Wood.....the Opry Square Dancers.....and the entire Grand Ole Opry gang !!

WAGGONER: Yessir...and our guest tonight is a young RCA Victor recording star who's as hot as a firecracker these days... Dave "Red Sweater" Rich !!
(APPLAUSE)

WAGGONER: Well, it looks like all the big labels are here tonight... 'cause here comes Capitol Records pride and joy and those Grand Ole Opry favorites, the Jordanaïres, doin' their hit song: "Each Day" !
(APPLAUSE)

(MUSIC OVER)

MUSIC: "EACH DAY!".....JORDANA IRES.
(APPLAUSE)

WAGGONER: Mighty fine, fellas, thank you. Now -- roll out the special
welcome mat 'cause here's our Grand Ole Opry guest....
Dave Rich !
(APPLAUSE)

WAGGONER: Dave -- welcome to the home of country music.

RICH: Thanks, Porter.

WAGGONER: Seems to me things have sure been poppin' for you since
you left Central City, Kentucky, Dave.

RICH: Sure have. (AD LIB RUNDOWN ON RECORDINGS, SHOWS,
PERSONALS)

WAGGONER: Well, I'll tell you somethin'..... I'm like all the folks here
at the Ryman tonight and listenin' in -- I'm waitin' for
that "Red Sweater."

RICH: Then here it comes.....

MUSIC: "RED SWEATER".....DAVE RICH
(APPLAUSE)

(ROD BRASFIELD OVER)

ROD: By Ned, it's almost time to go huntin' again, ain't it, Mister Porter?

WAGGONER: Sure is, Rod.

ROD: And I wanna tell all you hunters----there's just no friend on a huntin' trip like your favorite pipe, packed with Prince Albert Smoking Tobacco.

WAGGONER: Right, Rod. Prince Albert in your pipe is just as zesty and fresh as a cool, clear day in the woods.....

WAGGONER: As you know, it's an old custom here at the Grand Ole Opry to spend a moment or two each Saturday night with a song of faith. We hope you like the one we've picked for you tonight...one called: "Shake Hands With Mother Again"

MUSIC: "SHAKE HANDS WITH MOTHER AGAIN"... PORTER WAGGONER

(APPLAUSE)

WAGGONER: Thank you very much. Well sir -- it's time for some choice pickin's -- and that means another RCA Victor star of the Grand Ole Opry. Here's Chet Atkins and "Somebody Stole My Gal".

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "SOMEBODY STOLE MY GAL".....CHET ATKINS

WAGGONER: Real great.....Chet Atkins! Now--we'd like you to meet the Grand Ole Opry's gift to Jayne Mansfield...only she sent him back and we've got him..... Rod Brasfield !

(APPLAUSE & PLAYON)

WAGGONER: Grant -- those young fellas waitin' for you backstage there?

GRANT: Oh, yeah, Porter. They're some of our Grand Ole Opry fans from nearby universities. College boys....

WAGGONER: Well, I see they're all pipe-smokers.....

GRANT: ...Prince Albert pipe smokers. See, they've tried P.A. and they like the way it's s'fresh,...s'cool smoking.

WAGGONER: And college fellas go for the way P.A. lets 'em relax and enjoy a comfortable smoke...they love that natural, rich Prince Albert taste ! And the way P.A.'s crimp cut to burn long and slow and even.

GRANT: You fellas who roll your own...you don't have to go to college to study up and find out that P.A. is for you too !

WAGGONER: Right, Grant. Makin' men enjoy the same natural tobacco taste and smokin' comfort every time they roll their own with Prince Albert.
