GRANT: From the Ryman Auditorium in Nashville, Tennessee...the country music capital of the world...here's the 952nd broadcast of your Grand Ole Opry...tonight starring the king of country music.....ROY ACUFF !!

(A PPLAUSE)

MUSIC:

*Love and Needles In My Heart*  
"ONCE MORE".....ROY ACUFF

(A PPLAUSE)

ACUFF: Thank you, folks. We're always happy to have so many of you drop in to visit at the Grand Ole Opry. Grant Turner...tell the folks who's with us tonight !

GRANT: Sure will, Roy...there's Rod Brasfield ! Minnie Pearl ! Bashful Brother Oswald, Jimmy Riddle, Howdy Forrester, all the Smoky Mountain Boys ! the Grand Ole Opry Square Dancers and the entire Opry gang !

(ACUFF OVER)

ACUFF: Yessir ! And our special guest is Johnny Cash !!

(A PPLAUSE)

ACUFF: Well sir...if your new year didn't exactly get off to a crazy start, we're gonna take care of that right now. Here's the Hohenwald Flash...Rod Brasfield !

(A PPLAUSE & PLAYON)

(ROD)

(A PPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

ACUFF: Thank you, Rod. Here at the Grand Ole Opry, we've got a lot of fine young country music stars who have really been making a name for themselves and the Opry. Here's one of them now...our guest star.....Johnny Cash !

(A PPLAUSE)

ACUFF: Johnny...step right in, son.

CASH: Thanks , Roy !

(ACUFF OVER)

ACUFF: You know...just thinking back on it...this is the first time  
I've seen you in a long time. You been keeping busy?

CASH: Sure have, Roy. (AD LIB ON PERSONAL APPEARANCES, SHOWS,  
ETC)

ACUFF: Well, that's the way it is when the folks out there like you,  
And by the way...those "folks out there" ...are waiting to  
hear you sing, what'll it be?

CASH: (AD LIB INTO SONG)

MUSIC: "BALLAD OF A TEENAGE QUEEN".....JOHNNY CASH  
(APPLAUSE)

(ACUFF OVER)

ACUFF: Hey, Rod...what was this you were giving me this afternoon?  
Can you really tell a Prince Albert smoker from fifty feet?

• ROD: Positively.

ACUFF: ~~How???~~

ROD: By the smoke rings he blows.

ACUFF: ~~Now, come on, Rod..~~

ROD: I mean it ! Lotta smokers huff and puff, hoot and scoot. But  
by ned, a fella who packs his pipe with fine Prince Albert  
Smoking Tobacco.....he is comfortable. I dunno...there's  
just somethin' about P.A. that lets a fella be comfortable and  
enjoy himself.

ACUFF: Well...could be because Prince Albert smokes so smooth and cool  
...and packs real good , burns real slow, and lazy...and is  
so fresh.

ROD: That's what I mean ! When a fella puffs out a lazy smoke-ring,  
I know he's enjoying Prince Albert

(ACUFF OVER)

ACUFF:       Enjoying that very special...that "natural" Prince Albert taste...  
rich and fine. Say...you makin' men are due all that same  
fine taste and smoking comfort. P.A. rolls easy...smokes easy  
because it's crimp cut.

ROD:         Right ! Pipe smoker or makin' man.....

ACUFF:       ... Prince Albert Smoking Tobacco gives you fellas all the comfort  
all the natural tobacco taste, all the smoking enjoyment you  
could ask for ! Get Prince Albert !

MUSIC:       FIDDLE..."GOLDEN EAGLE HORNPIPE "....FADE FOR:

ACUFF:       Here's Howdy Forrester with the "Golden Eagle Hornpipe !"   
and that means ole time fiddling' and ole time dancing with the  
Grand Ole Opry Square Dancers !!!

MUSIC:       "GOLDEN EAGLE HORNPIPE"....SQUARE DANCE  
(APPLAUSE)

(ACUFF OVER)

ACUFF: Well sir...as all our Opry friends know...we always try to include a sacred song along with our Grand Ole Opry singing and dancing and fun. Our song tonight is an old one...a mellow old favorite of ours and we hope of yours too..."Precious Memories."

MUSIC: *"Won't It Be Wonderful"*  
"PRECIOUS MEMORIES".....ROY ACUFF

(APPLAUSE)

ACUFF: Thank you. We haven't heard a single toot from Jimmy Riddle on his old harmonica...so let's welcome Jimmy and "Dill Pickles!"

MUSIC: "DILL PICKLES".....JIMMY RIDDLE

(APPLAUSE)

ACUFF: Thank you, Jimmy. Well...this next Grand Ole Opry star...I like her so much and have known her so long, I can never make up anything fancy to say to bring her on. It's always seemed seemed enough to just say...folks ...here's...cousin...Minnie... Pearl !!

(APPLAUSE & PLAYON)

(MINNIE OVER)

(MINNIE PEARL)

(APPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

MINNIE: Roy...next week, can Hezzy come on this here Prince Albert Grand Ole Opry and sing his new song?

ACUFF: Well, I don't know, Minnie. What's the song?

MINNIE: It's a love ballad called: "I'm Just Wild About Prince Albert Smoking Tobacco."

ACUFF: Well...Minnie...I get the idea but...

MINNIE: Hezzy's expressive, ain't he?

ACUFF: Yeah...

MINNIE: See, he loves the way Prince Albert Smoking Tobacco tastes ! Says P.A. keeps all the flavor Nature puts in tobacco. Says P.A. draws that flavor out even finer and richer and tastier.

ACUFF: I know, Minnie, but...

MINNIE: ...Hezzy says Prince Albert's so comfortable to smoke...so fresh and cool...burns so nice and lazy.

ACUFF: Well, Minnie, pipe smokers everywhere agree with Hezzy. And y'know, makin' men sure enjoy the way crimp cut Prince Albert rolls up into a smooth-makin', smooth'smokin' cigarette. It's got the makins of a perfect smoke !

MUSIC: "ROLL ON BUDDY ROLL ON".....OSWALD

(A PPLA USE)

(GUITAR STRUM IN BG)

(ACUFF OVER)
