GRANT: From the Ryman Auditorium in Nashville, Tennessee...the country music capitol of the world...here's the 991st broadcast of the GRAND....OLEOPRY.....tonight starring...EDDY ARNOLD !!

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "I'M A GOOD BOY"...EDDY ARNOLD

(APPLAUSE)

EDDY: Thank you....thank you very much and welcome to the Grand Ole Opry. And here's my old friend Grant Turner. Grant...how about leadin' off with the line up of entertainers ?

GRANT: Be happy to, Eddy. First off...we've got Cousin Minnie Pearl aboard...

EDDY:and the Jordanaires...Chester Atkins, for some fine guitar playin'...

GRANT: ...yes...and Miss Del Wood..., Tommy Jackson and the Opry Square Dancers...

EDDY: AND....our very special guest...STONEWALL JACKSON !!

(APPLAUSE)

(EDDY OVER)

EDDY: We'll be hearin' from Stonewall in just a little while...but right now it's my pleasure to introduce a really great singin' group.....the JORDANAIREs....all set to sing, "_____."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "_____"...JORDANAIREs

(APPLAUSE)

EDDY: The Jordanaires...and "_____." Thank you, boys...that was great. Well now...I always say that when you've got a great guest...you ought to use him...and tonight..we've got a boy who is really tops. He's a great showman and a favorite with all the Opry Listeners...so let's give him a great big hand....STONEWALL JACKSON !!

(APPLAUSE)

EDDY: Stonewall...it's certainly nice to have you here with us at the Grand Ole Opry.

STONEWALL: It's great to be here, Eddy.

EDDY: Everybody's tellin' me that you've got a great new song out for Columbia Records, Stonewall...and I wonder if we could get you to sing it for us ?

STONEWALL: Eddy.... I don't believe you could keep me from it.

(EDDY OVER)

EDDY: I thought it was somethin' like that. Here he is, folks....
Stonewall Jackson...and his great new song...."Life To Go."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "LIFE TO GO"...STONEWALL JACKSON

(APPLAUSE)

STONEWALL: (EXCITED) Hey Eddy....have you been follerin' th' world series ?

EDDY: Hasn't everybody, Stonewall ?

STONEWALL: I reckon so ! You all'll pardon th' expression...but them northerners have sure got some ball clubs. It's a pleasure to watch 'em play.

EDDY: Naturally, Stonewall. It's always a pleasure to see champions in action. In a way...that's why so many pipe smokers like Prince Albert Smokin' Tobacco. P.A. IS a champion, you know, It's America's LARGEST selling smoking tobacco.

STONEWALL: (LOOKING AT HIM) I was just wonderin' how you was gonna get around to Prince Albert. All jokin' aside...P.A. IS a great smokin' tobacco. Gives a man th' most COMFORTABLE smoke he can get.

EDDY: Why not, Stonewall. P.A. is always fresh.

STONEWALL: It's crimp cut...

EDDY: ...an' it's mild and mellow. The flavor is just right for smokin' pleasure. That's because that special P.A. process locks IN all the natural goodness of the fine tobacco.

STONEWALL: P.A.'s a favorite with makin' men, too. Rolls easy...smokes good.

EDDY: So pipe smoker OR makin' man...join up with a champion. Get a satisfyin'...cool...tasty...comfortable smoke with Prince Albert. See for yourself why it's called..."America's Joy Smoke."

MUSIC: "SALLY GOOD'N".....T. JACKSON...ESTAB...FADE UNDER AS BG FOR...

EDDY: Now, here's Tommy Jackson, his fiddle and all the Opry Square Dancers...so if you feel in the mood...just grab a partner and join in the dancin' to the tune of that old timer..."Sally Goodin."

MUSIC: "SALLY GOOD IN"...T. JACKSON & SQUARE DANCERS

EDDY: Thank you, Tommy Jackson and Square Dancers. I haven't had so much fun for a long time.

MUSIC CUE: SNEAK IN HYMN UNDERSCORE...SOFTLY....AS...

(EDDY OVER)

EDDY: But while we're havin' fun here at the Grand Ole Opry we never let our minds get too far away from Him who is all wise...all forgiving. And then our minds turn to the old hymns and to the message they contain. Here's one that's always been a favorite of mine.... I hope it is one of yours.

MUSIC: "THOUGH YOUR SINS BE AS SCARLET"....EDDY ARNOLD
(APPLAUSE)

EDDY: Thank you...thanks so much. You're very kind.

GRANT: Eddy...that was great. Simply beautiful.

EDDY: Grant...that's nice of you to say so.

GRANT: Say, Eddy...do you happen to know what next Monday is ?

EDDY: Grant...it just so happens that I do. October 6th is the 33rd birthday of Radio Station WSM.

GRANT: Right you are, Eddy. 33 years of fine programs and service to the listening public.

EDDY: Our congratulations to WSM and all the fine people on the staff. But now we've got to get on with the show....so what would you suggest ?

(GRANT OVER)

GRANT: Well, Eddy...if I were runnin' things I'd say it was time we heard from that master of the electric guitar....with one of those fine tunes he does.

EDDY: Good suggestion, Grant. Folks..here he is....CHET ATKINS.. with that grand old standard..."Show Me the Way To Go Home."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: 'SHOW ME THE WAY TO GO HOME'...CHET ATKINS

(APPLAUSE)

EDDY: Thank you, Chet Atkins....thanks for that fine bit of playin'. You know...besides bein' one of the country's great guitar players...Chester is sort of the head man out at the RCA Victor studios here in Nashville. And speakin' of head man...it's my pleasure to introduce a great friend of mine...and yours... that head WOMAN...Cousin MINNIE PEARL ! !

(APPLAUSE & PLAY ON)

MINNIE

(APPLAUSE & PLAY OFF)

EDDY: Minnie, how's your sister and her boy friend gettin' on ?

MINNIE: They ain't. While sister was playin' "hard to get" he met a gal who believed in "love at first sight."

(EDDY OVER)

EDDY: Too bad, Minnie, but that's sort of the way it is when a man tries Prince Albert Smokin' Tobacco in his pipe for the first time.

MINNIE: An' sister woulda been SUCH a comfort to him.

MUSIC: TAG WITH JINGLE

EDDY: Now it's time we heard from our guest again...so here he is.. with another of his Columbia recordings....STONEWALL JACKSON and a song called..."Misery Known as Heartache."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "MISERY KNOWN AS HEARTACHE"....STONEWALL JACKSON

(APPLAUSE)

(EDDY OVER)

EDDY: Thank you, Stonewall, Jackson...thanks so much. You're a great guest and a great entertainer. Which brings us down to the spot in the show where we introduce another great featured performer. Let's have a big round of applause for the girl who really plays the daylights out of a piano...the "Down Yonder" Girl herself....DEL WOOD !!

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "DOWN YONDER"...DEL WOOD

(APPLAUSE)

EDDY: Thank you, Del...thank you very much. Only on the Opry can you hear piano-playin' like that. Yes sir.

GRANT: Well, Eddy...we only hear the best of EVERYTHING here at the Opry...and that includes songs by the one and only Eddy Arnold. I know that first tune was one of your RCA Victor records...but will you tell us a little bit about the next song you're gonna do ?

EDDY: I'll be glad to, Grant. (EDDY ADLIBS BRIEFLY ABOUT HIS TUNES)

GRANT: Well, great, Eddy. Here he is, neighbors....Eddy Arnold...with one of his latest... "Till You Come Back Again."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "TILL YOU COME BACK AGAIN"...EDDY ARNOLD

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "TOM & JERRY"...T. JACKSON..FADE UNDER AS BG FOR:
(EDDY OVER)

EDDY: That's it for tonight, neighbors...but before I go I want to say that it was sure great havin' you with us here at the Grand Ole Opry. Next week _____ will be heading up the show and he'll have _____ along as his guest...so join us then, won't you. Now...this is Eddy Arnold sayin' "So long...be good, everybody"...and we'll be seein' you next week at the GRAND....OLE....OPRY !!
