(APPLAUSE)

GRANT: Hank Snow, the singing ranger, and all the Rainbow Ranch Boys, with Hank's very latest RVA Victor release... 'The Last Ride.' Hank...that's a great song !

HANK: Well...thank you, Grant !

GRANT: Right there at the first, it reminds me a little of your other big one.... 'Movin' On.' But speakin' of movin' on... we got to get on with the show...and a really great one it is tonight, neighbors. We are just LOADED with talent. First off, there's Cousin Minnie Pearl and Archie Campbell. Chet Atkins is here with his guitar and Del Wood with her big piano. Then Tommy Jackson, who plays that wonderful fiddle is here...along with Ralph Stan and all the Tennessee Travelers...to show us some great square dancin'.

GRANT: Just savin' the best for the last, Hank. Neighbors....as our special guest tonight we've got that great entertainer who hails from down Texas way...that singer of FINE songs...

GRANT: Floyd will be out here in just a few minubs to sing one of his great songs.....Right now I want you to meet a man who has really got a sunburn...In fact he is so sunburned he is the TOAST of the town.....ARCHIE CAMPBELL !!

(ARCHIE'S ROUTINE)

(APPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

GRANT: Archie Campbell...the pride of Bulls Gap, Tennessee . Thank you, Archie...for your words of wisdom. But now its time we had a few words with our guest...so let's have a great big Grand Ole Opry welcome for him...your friend and mineFLOYD TILMAN !!

(APPLAUSE)

GRANT: Floyd...welcome to the Grand Ole Opry !

(TILMAN OVER)

TILMAN: Good to be here with you , Grant. Hank...It's always a pleasure to work a show with you.

HANK: Sure is a pleasure, Floyd. Been a long time. Too long, in fact.

GRANT: Floyd...it HAS been a long time since you got up here to visit with us. You got any new songs out?

TILMAN: Oh sure, Grant....always got new songs. But you know me....I like the OLD ones.

GRANT: Know what you mean, son...know what you mean. So how about singin' one? Here he is, neighbors....our guest... with his great song from way back in 1948...."I Love You So Much It Hurts Me". FLOYD TILMAN !!

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "I LOVE YOU SO MUCH IT HURTS ME"...FLOYD TILMAN

(APPLAUSE)

GRANT: *Floyd* Hank...when it comes right down to it, what's the most important thing about smoking tobacco?

GRANT: Well, Hank...I'm always just a little partial to the religious
songs and the fine old hymns....so if you don't mind...

MUSIC CUE: SNEAK IN UNDERSCORE....SOFTLY....

GRANT: ...how about that one that tells of His compassion and
help to us when our way is troubled. "He'll Understand
and Say Well Done."

MUSIC: "HE'LL UNDERSTAND AND SAY WELL DONE"...HANK SNOW
(APPLAUSE)

HANK: Thank you....thanks just a lot, friends and neighbors....
thanks so very much. And now, it's my pleasure to introduce
one of our featured C O PRY acts...that great guitar player and
wonderful friend,CHET ATKINS !!

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC" "BICYCLE BUILT FOR TWO".....CHET ATKINS
(APPLAUSE)

(GRANT C O VER)

GRANT: Chet Atkins and "Bicycle Built For Two"...Thank you,
Chet....thanks a lot. And now, Hank...how about
introducing our NEXT performer?

HANK: Be glad to, Grant...but what can I say besides...."Now
Here She Is.....COUSIN MINNIE PEARL !!

(APPLAUSE & PLAY ON)

(MINNIE'S ROUTINE)

APPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

PROD NOTE: PLAY ET...# 439..... *Hank Snow* Cut # 10

GRANT: Now it's "guest time" once again....so here's Floyd Tilman
back with another of his great tunes...."DAISY MAE" !

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: " DAISY MAE".....FLOYD TILMAN

(APPLAUSE)

GRANT: Floyd Tilman and "Daisy Mae". Thank you Floyd...and
thanks for bein' here with us tonight. But now the
show gets bigger and faster as Del Wood steps to the
piano to play the title song from her big RCA Victor Album...
"Down Yonder !"

(APPLAUSE)

(MUSIC OVER)

MUSIC: "DOWN YONDER".....DEL WOOD

(APPLAUSE)

GRANT: Thank you, Del., that was wonderful. But now it's time we turned the spotlight back on our star for another song... but before you sing, Hank., how about givin' us a little rundown on your future plans ?

HANK: AD LIBS BRIEFLY ABOUT COMING TRIP TO CANADA

GRANT: Hank., I know you have the best wishes of all our Opry audience. Now., how about that song? Here he is, neighbors.,.,., Hank Snow., with one of his latest RCA VICTOR records.,., "The Party of the Second Part."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "THE PARTY OF THE SECOND PART".....HANK SNOW

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "STONEY POINT.....T. JACKSON...FADE UNDER AS BG FOR:

HANK: Neighbors .,., that's the show for this evening but before we go I want to thank all of you for bein' here with us at The Grand Ole Opry. Listen NEXT week when Marty Robbins will be the star and will have Stonewall Jackson along as his guest. Now., this is Hank Snow, sayin' "Thanks",... and we'll be seein' you NEXT week at THE...GRAND...OLE... OPRY !!
