OPENING SIGNATURE

AMNOUNCER:

Here we are, boys and girls, with another thrilling episode in the adventures of Tom Mix --- the cowboy here. The very same Tom Mix you have seen in those thrilling western movies. And you know how peppy and full of energy Tom is. Tom knows the secret of keeping phymiatly fit. He stays outdoors a lot in the fresh air. And he eats the right foods. And Tom says that one of the best cereals for growing boys and girls to eat is RALSTON WHEAT CEREAL ---- the straight shooter's own brand of cereal. TOM: All right...follow me...and everyone stay close...

WRANGLER: What I can't figger Tom ... is why that ornery critter

Mountain Pete don't come out of his hidin' place...he

shore must know he's got us now ....

TOM: Don't know Wrangler...that polecat thinks jest like a

pizen snake....

JANE: (LOW) Maybe this passage will take us right to the

Fort grounds ....

WRANGLER: Tom! Wait ... I heard something ... from this side of the

passage.

TOM: Where Wrangler ....?

WRANGLER: Right here....get my ear close to the wall and listen ...

JIMMY: Gosh...Tom...how can that be?

TOM: These forts are built with all sorts of contraptions...

secret walls...and passages...and everything...to fool

the enemy ...

WRANGLER: I hear something all right...voices....Tom....you

listen --- you've got keener hearin....

TOM: Shhhhh...quiet everyone...

JANE: What is it Tom?

JIMMY: Shhhh...sis...wait...

WRANGLER: Hear it Tom?

TOM: Footsteps...many men walking...on the other side of this

passageway.

WRANGLER: Tom...look....the passage gets smaller up ahead....we

can't get out that way.

TOM: Say....that is funny....why....cattle couldn't get

through there ....

JIMMY: No room at all to get even one head a cattle through.

JANE: Then the cattle didn't come in through here...

TOM: I'm not so sure about that...why....I'll bet this wall

here...where we heard the sounds...moves!

JIMMY: Moves !

JANE: Goah Tom...how can that be?

TOM: Easy enough in an old Fort...why that's what makes these

old forts so doggone mysterious..... (OVER)

TOM: (CONT) They've got every sort of contraption to fool you.....

WRANGLER: Tom....you're right about that...our only chance is

to get on the other side of this fake wall .... this

moving wall ..

JIMMY: Gosh...a moving wall.

TOM: We can try getting on the other side...by digging.

WRANGLER: It's our only hope Tom.

JANE: But...how...how can we dig through a dirt wall?

TOM: That's just it Jane ... it's not a dirt wall .... it

only looks like it ..... why jest listen to this sound

as I knock on it ....

BUSINESS: (DULL POUNDING ON WOOD PANEL)

JIMMY: Sounds just like wood Tom.

JANE: It does.

TOM. And that's what it is .... a wooden wall ... that works on

some sort of lever....just like a derrick.....or

drawbridge. And we're gonna get on the other side of

this wall ....

WRANGLER: Tom...I'll start digging down below here...right at the

bottom..., and it's a good thing we've both got our

huntin' knives with us.

TOM: Let me help you Wrangler ... that's the best way to work ..

from the bottom...Jane...Jimmy....you use your spurs to

dig away the dirt under the wall ....

JIMMY: All right...

JANE: Ohh ... maybe we'll find a way out all right.

JIMMY: We will sis...and maybe we'll find all the mystery of

this old fort too ...

TOM: Knife gettin' through the bottom easy.

(SCRAPING SOUNDS)

WRANGLER: Wood's danged rottent.

TOM: Won't take us long to make a big enough hole.

WRANGLER: Tom....there must be something behind this wall that'll

help us get a clue to that critter's whereabouts.

JANE: Lockit the pile of dirt I've dug up already.

JIMMY: Gosh.... I can almost get through to the other side.

TOM: That's workin' hard kids ... . why ... . we're hot on the

trail now ... we're gettin' somewheres.

JIMMY: We are ... and we'll show Mountain Pete.

WRANGLER: That's the courage Jimmy.

TOM: Shhh ... . wait ... stop digging ... . this hole's big enough

for us to hear ..

WRANGLER: (TENSE) What do you hear Tom?

TOM: Somewheres on the other side... Mountain Pete's voice...

JANE: Gosh....

TOM: Shhhhh...listen Mountain Pete...below...

somewheres ...

FADE IN TO:

PETE: (LAUGHS) Well...we got 'em...and it's him that's

gonna get the lesson....Tom Mix....I'll teach him to

keep outta Mountain Pete's affairs ....

FAINE: You bet we will Pete...and yer can depend on me,

MacFaine, to do my part.... They sure fell for our trap.

(LAUGHS)

PETE: And they ain't all.

FAINE: But what we gonna do with them...now we got em chief?

PETE: Don't you worry about that....I'll fix 'em....

FAINE: But we let that Indian kid get away....we couldn stopped

him easy enough...but you said no. What's the idea, chief

... gosh.. that kid ull get help from the Double Diamond.

PETE:

(LAUGHS) Sure he will....That's just what I want him to do. That's why I let him get away....Why none of yer ain't got brains at all.....to figger things out.

FA INE:

Say chief...where do you get that stuff. That kid ull spread the word around...and afore we know it all the cowboys from the Doulbe Diamond will come ridin' herd on us....gosh....we'll not only have a scrap on our hands...but mebbe lose the cattle---and queer our hideout.

PETE:

(SARCASTICALLY) Jest as I thought, MacFaine...yer ain't got the brains of a flea...

FAINE:

Aw...Pete...now what's the idea anyway...why...er....

PETE:

Now listen to me! Yer worried thinkin they're gonna swing us fer this.

FAINE:

I ain't ever feeling too good when I thinks about a necktie party...

PETE:

Now you don't think I'm a fool do you?

FAINE:

Don't reckon as how you ever heard me say that, Pete, ...but....

PETE:

There ain't no buts at all. Now lissen to me, Faine...

I had a good reason for lettin that Indian kid get away
for help...Because I want help to come to the Fort!!!

FAINE:

You....you really want them Double Diamond cowboys ridin' down on us? Why Pete...yer clear outta yore mind.

PETE:

(LAUGHS) Wait...wait...you thick-headed coyote. You don't get this at all. There's a lot of cattle on the Double Diamond, ain't there.?

FAINE:

Yeah ....

PETE:

A lot more than we rustled from Old Sam Hicks.

FAINE:

But what's that got to do with help the Indian kids getti

PETE:

A lot of that Double Diamond herd is in now....a lot of the prize heads...right on the ranch...now....if all the Double Diamond boys come ridin down here.... the ranch ain't gonna be guarded....

FAINE:

Yer gonna raid the ranch in broad daylight?

PETE:

You bet I am....that's why I sent word for the rest of the gang to get ready. We'll lead the few cattle we've got up in the Fort Parade grounds through the secret pass on the opposite hill....and head em for Little Falls....

FAINE:

But. .

PITE:

That'll take care of the cattle we got on hand now...
and then when the Double Diamond cowboys ride down
here....to help find the kids and Tom Mix....we'll
raid the ranch....

FAINE:

It beats all pardner...how you can think up these plans...but wait. What'll we do with the kids and Mix and that other guy down in the underground passage now....

PETE:

and I got that all figgered out too. We'll jest let em stay there. (LAUGHS) No one ull ever find em... and afore we go just to make sure they'll be out of the way for good....we'll release the crash controls at the top of the passage....you know what that ull do, eh?

FAINE:

Yeah...yeah...gosh...there's all that gravel in a chute
....and when it's released it ull block the main
passageway---and sort of cover up anybody or anything
that happens to be there...

PETE:

(LAUGHING) Yeah ... yeah ... won't that be something ...

FAIME: Gosh...chief....if anything goes wrong...they'll hang

us for this.

PETE: (LAUGHS) Hang nothin .... why .... we'll do this so fast.

... they won't know what's happened... and after we get

to Little Falls...cattle 'n all...it'll be a cinch

gettin' across the Border. We'll be safe!

FAINE: Well.... I ain't a-goin' to back out now, chief...but

we gotta be mighty careful.

PETE: All you gotta do is to follow orders....now....we'll go

up and take a look-see out of the top lookout on the

Fort....things oughta be happenin' pretty quick.....

FAINE: Ain't yer gonna take a look at Mix and the kids?

PETE: What for? I know they can't get away. We got both

the top and the bottom of the passage fixed.

FAINE: Yeah...that's all right chief...as long as they don't

find this room here where the lever controls are ..

PETE: Don't be so doggone stupid. How can they get through

that fake wall ... when they don't even know there is a

fake wall ... (FADING) Come on ... let's go up to the

Fort lookout and see ....

FAINE: (FADING) All right...I'm a-comin..... (FADE OUT)

( PAUSE)

FADE IN TO:

JIMMY: (LOW) Gosh...didja hear them...

JANE: (LOW) Ohhh.

TOM: They're bad hombres all right...they won't stop at

anything ...

WRANGLER: Tom....they're gonna set out for the ranch and raid it.

JANE: Steal all of dad's cattle...

WRANGLER: Tom. .. we're in a bad spot.

TOM: Tain't very comfortable...not after hearin' about that

lever which controls the gravel that ull bottle up this

passage way.

JIMMY: Gosh...if we dig...and get through this wall.

JANE: Oh...we've got to do it...we must....

WRANGLER: Tom....I've seen you in mighty bad situations...and

I've faith in anything you say or do ... and I know

right now you're mind's working hard ... . you can get us

out...

TOM: I'll get you out...and I'll stop them hombres from

there ornery work ... there's hope ... but we've got to

work like beavers.

JIMMY: We will Tom...we'll do anyting...me and Jane are ready

to do anything.

TOM: Good. And our big hope is in getting through behind

this fake wall .....

WRANGLER: If we can get onto the other side...where they are...

where Mountain Pete has the secret room where the

lever controls are...we'll have the upper hand.

TOM: That's the room we've got to get too ... it's the most

important place in this fort.

WRANGLER: You're right Tom.
