


RADIO PROGRAM TIMELINES: 1920 - 1980

A Charted Cross-Reference of American Radio Broadcasting Displaying Program Titles, Broadcasting Timelines, Sponsorship, and Network Affiliation

Opening Notes

During the past nine years I have been collecting, organizing, and utilizing recordings of Old Time Radio programs in my social science classes at the junior high school and community college levels. The shows have been presented as social comment of historical interest, as substance of Old Time Radio History, and as sheer delightful entertainment. All the while, however, the students and I have noted the need for a comparative display of broadcast dates, sponsorship, and network affiliation information. Other researchers have gathered and gleaned a great deal of this kind of information (see bibliography), but to date it has been scattered and unorganized.

This reference book attempts to systematically list and graphically display this fundamental information on 148 selected radio programs from the history of radio broadcasting, 1920 to 1980. Now you can conveniently retrieve information of titles, times, sponsors, and networks from the pages presented here. Additional space is provided at the end of the graphic section so that you might add timelines of other favorites from radio (see page 24).

Design and Organization

Each timeline is designed to present three sets (or lines) of information:

- (1) top portion presents the network abbreviation using the appropriate color in the middle run of the timeline.

N = NBC	: National Broadcasting Company	(red)
C = CBS	: Columbia Broadcasting System	(black)
M = MBS	: Mutual Broadcasting System	(green)
A = ABC	: American Broadcasting Company	(blue)
O = Other Networks	(incl A.F.R.S.)	(purple)
IS = Independent Station		(orange)
Syn = Syndication by Private Firm		(brown)

- (2) middle portion (to be colored) represents the time period(s) during which the program was aired - keyed as given above.

- (3) bottom portion gives the abbreviation of the sponsor (note, Appendix B: Key to Sponsor Abbreviation - page 27). Space on this line did not permit lengthy spellings of product or parent company name.

Recent CBS radio dramatic productions are programming phenomena of the 1970s, spanning beyond the scope of the timeline graphs. So data of these programs was merely typed at the right edge of the timeline.

Information Accuracy


The facts displayed in this graphic complication are as accurate as available sources permit. Obviously data on some of the favorite and lesser known radio programs has been lost to historic negligence. Question marks are placed on timelines where data is unknown, or where obvious contradictions surface.

Color the middle section of each of the radio program timelines in accordance with this color scheme. And presto, you will possess a quick reference to each of the selected programs. POSTSCRIPT

As this research/graphics project proceeded it loomed larger and larger, potentially a major work could develop. It was felt afterward that a few postscript comments were needed.

Presented to you have been the skeletal facts of 148 radio programs, their broadcasting periods, network affiliation, and sponsorship information given primarily in timeline form with cross reference appendices.

The writer views this publication as the initial stage of an extensive project which could include additional programs suggested by you and others possibly to total 250. Future work could show sponsorship timelines visualizing the periods each company lent its support to radio entertainment (taken from Appendix D).

In addition the writer sees potential for analysis of this bank of data in attempt to draw out possible patterns of

- a. types of successful programs each network tended to carry
- b. associations of program success with historic periods in America
- c. sponsorship support-from Appendix C, at what historic times did certain groups of sponsors (or individual sponsors) lend support to the radio industry? Did specific sponsors carry only a specific type of program? And, were specific sponsors inclined to work with only one particular network at a time? What were the patterns if any?

This study is a beginning effort. Since research on American radio programming is in its infancy, more accurate data may supplant that which we have now.
